Friday Devotional: Psalm 4:6-8 Many are saying, "Who will show us any good?"

Lift up the light of Your countenance upon us, O Lord!

7 You have put gladness in my heart,
More than when their grain and new wine abound.
8 In peace I will both lie down and sleep,
For You alone, O Lord, make me to dwell in safety.

How to seek a word (verse) from the Lord:

1) Foundation

1a) We are commanded to meditate. Joshua 1:8

1b) We have been promised to hear the voice of Jesus. John 10:27

2) Start with surrender. Proverbs 3:6; 1 Samuel 3:10; Psalm 25:4-5

3) Repent and reflect. Psalm 77:11-12

4) Saturate yourself with Scripture. Psalm 119:105; Hebrews 4:12

5) Submit to The Holy Spirit. John 14:26

6) Test it:

6a) Test it by Scripture. 2 Timothy 3:16-17

6b) Test it by the witness of others. 1 Corinthians 13:1; Acts 15:28

6c) Test it by the spiritual results. 1 Thessalonians 5:21; Romans 8:29;
Galatians 5:22-23; James 1:22

7) Clarity helps faithfulness. Proverbs 4:22-27

8) Pray it into my life. Philippians 1:9-11, Ephesians 1:17-19; Colossians 1:9-12

9) Continue to meditate. Psalm 1:2-3

10) Hold it loosely. Job 1:21

God gives us a new/ renewed heart.

Ezekiel 36:26-27; Jeremiah 24:7

- God initiates my transformation.
- I can feel grateful for the change from a heart of stone to one with which God is working.
- I can embrace the initiative of God Who wants to be known and draws near.
- I can say, "Lord, keep forming my heart to embrace you."

- I can identify an area where there is resistance to the prompting of the Holy Spirit and I can talk to Him about it.

God gives emotional renewal, healing, restoration.

Psalm 34:18; Psalm 147:3; Psalm 42:5

- God is near in my pain; not distant.
- My emotions are real but not final.
- My despair is not the end of the story.
- I can honestly grieve before God.
- I am comforted knowing that God binds wounds; He does not ignore wounds.
- Ask God to meet you in your place of hurt.
- Bring your hurt to God in prayer.
- Share your burden with a trusted believer for support.

God gives renewal of the inner person.

Colossians 3:10; 2 Corinthians 4:16

- Renewal is a daily process, not a one-time event.
- My inner person is being reshaped into the image of Jesus Christ.
- I can feel encouraged that the bible says that my inner renewal continues even when the outer life feels pressured/ under decay.
- Because I have hope in God that Christ is being formed in me, I can look for places in me where God is at work.
- I can meditate on one scriptural truth about that inner renewal each morning.
- Ask, "Where was I renewed today?" "Where was I resistant?"

God gives peace, and comfort.

Philippians 4:6-7; John 14:27 Isaiah 26:3; Psalm 94:19

- Peace is a gift from Christ, it is not something I manufacture.
- It is God Who guards my heart and mind.
- I can identify my anxious thought patterns and redirect them towards the character and promises of God.
- The peace of God is accessible in the midst of uncertainty.
- I can trust that God is holding what I cannot control.
- As I rest in the nearness of God, I can allow the comfort of God to replace the agitation I may be feeling.
- I can turn my worries into prayers.
- I can practice a daily prayer that includes thanksgiving.
- I can memorize and meditate on a peace-related verse and speak it aloud when I am feeling stressed/ anxious.

God calls us to purify and guard our heart.

Proverbs 4:23; Psalm 139:23-24; James 4:8

- My heart is the wellspring of my life, it must be guarded.
- God reveals what I cannot see about myself.
- I can feel open to correction and cleansing.
- I believe that God does search and know my heart.
- Drawing near to God results in purification.
- "Search me, O God, and know my heart."
- "Lord, reveal any hurtful way in me."
- I can identify areas where my heart is getting polluted and set helpful boundaries.
- I can engage in confession regularly.

- I can draw near to God through scripture, prayer, and worship.

God gives us joy, and strength.

Nehemiah 8:10; Psalm 73:25-26

- God is my portion. God is enough.
- “The joy of the Lord is my strength.”
- “Whom have in heaven but You?”
- I can celebrate the goodness of God intentionally (feasting, sharing, rejoicing).
- I can practice gratitude by naming three things every day.
- I can enjoy a deepening delight in the presence of God.
- When I am discouraged, I can create a moment of worship.

God calls us to confession, and repentance.

Psalm 51:2-4a; Psalm 51:10; Psalm 51:12

- Repentance restores intimacy.
- Repentance is a gift that restores joy.
- I can believe that God delights to cleanse and renew.
- I can allow a Godly sorrow to lead me to freedom, not despair.
- I can receive the relief from God when I have confessed to Him. Confess specifics.
- “Wash me and cleanse me.”
- “Create in me a clean heart.”
- Practice self-examination with God.
- Turn away from sin decisively and walk forward in grace.

God gives us hope, joy, and peace as we believe.

Isaiah 41:10; Romans 15:13

- Replace doom and gloom thinking with reminders of the presence of God and the help of God.
- Focus on the promises of God rather than what I fear.
- My hope is powered by the Holy Spirit not my willpower or “positivity.”
- I can trust that God is actively upholding me.
- I can allow hope to steady my emotions.
- When I feel fear, I can speak the promises of God.
- I can pray for the Holy Spirit to fill me with joy and peace.
- I can take the next step forward even when I am feeling weak.
- I can pray Romans 15:13 over me and those I love every morning.

How can I embrace the renewal of my heart?

- Remember and believe that it is God Who renews my heart.
- It is God Who gives emotional renewal, healing and restoration.
- God renews the inner person.
- God calls us to purify and guard our heart.
- God gives joy and strength.
- God calls us to confession and repentance.
- God gives us hope, joy, and peace as we believe

Participate with God as He forms Christ in me.
