Friday's Devotional from 1 Corinthians 1:26-29 For consider your calling, brethren, that there were not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble; 27 but God has chosen the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to shame the things which are strong, 28 and the base things of the world and the despised God has chosen, the things that are not, so that He may nullify the things that are, 29 so that no man may boast before God.

Psalm 31: Stressed!

- Background:
 - Saul or Absalom is chasing David.
 - Saul: jealousy and fear.
 - Absalom: greed and pride.
- Challenges:
 - Illness, Adversaries, Shunned by friends, Death threats,
 - Speaks of Jesus' suffering.

Psalm 31: David's Psalm

- David's Plea (vss 1-5).
- David's Passion (vss 6-8).
- David's Pain (vss 9-13).
- David's Petition (vss 14-18).
- David's Praise (vss 19-22).
- David's Proclamation (23-24).

Elements of David's prayer:

- Praises.
- Fears.
- Asks.
- Thanks.
- Hopes.
- Explains.
- **R**ejoices.

What can we learn?

- We want logic and orderly flow.
- Life isn't and doesn't.
- We have to circle back (vss. 1-8 -> vss. 9-24).
- If you feel something, say something..., to God.
 - David spoke: Problems, Prayers, Praises.
 - Went from anguish to assurance.
 - Went from fear and trembling to comfort and strength.

Psalm 116 A Thanksgiving Psalm

1 I love the Lord, because He hears

My voice and my pleas.

2 Because He has inclined His ear to me,

Therefore I will call upon Him as long as I live.

3 The snares of death encompassed me

And the terrors of Sheol came upon me;

- I found distress and sorrow.
- 4 Then I called upon the name of the Lord:
- "Please, Lord, save my life!"
