Jeremiah 31:3 The Lord appeared to him from afar, saying, "I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore, I have drawn you with lovingkindness."

John 15:9 "Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love." Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Process:


- 1) Knowledge

Philippians:

- Rejoice! (The why, the what, the how).
- Unity matters. The why, the what, the how).
- Be like Jesus. (Humility, Unselfish)
- My side: Loved, Obey, Resources.
- God's side: Powerful, Active, Committed
- Stop complaining.
- Joy: Sacrifice, Submission, Risk-Love
- Christians: Joy, faith vs Non-Christians: works
- Heavenly citizenship vs Enemy of the Cross

Life of Joseph: But this is not my plan "A" Joseph' Family Background:

- Father is Jacob. The father of Jacob preferred the brother of Jacob, Esau. Jacob schemes to steal the blessing of Esau (using a coat).
- Jacob was a schemer all his life until he came to the end of himself and wrestled with God). That night, the name of Jacob is changed to Israel.
- Laban is the father-in-law, who cheats Jacob. Jacob is tricked into marrying Leah. Then Jacob marries Rachel.
- Wife he loves is Rachel. Rachel is barren for a long time.
- Each wife gives handmaidens to Jacob in order to have more children.
- Rachel eventually has Joseph late in life.
- Rachel then has Benjamin and dies.



Life of Joseph

- Birth to 17 years old (Genesis 30:24-37:2). Whole family is on the move. Unresolved family issues: clashes, arguments, jealousy, hatred. Jacob seems passive throughout.
- 17 to 30 years old (Genesis 37:2-41:46): Life out of the control of Joseph (slavery, unjust accusations, imprisonment)
- 30 years to death at 110 years (Genesis 41:46-50:26): Prosperity, blessing of God. Joseph is the blessing to his family through forgiving, providing, and protecting.

Joseph betrayed (Genesis 37)

- The brothers herd the flocks. Joseph helps.
- Joseph is the favorite of his father (robe).
- Joseph gives bad reports about the brothers.

- The brothers know Joseph is the favored one, and jealousy turns to hatred.
- Joseph tells of two dreams that foretell the future.
- All are offended.
- Jacob asks Joseph to check up on the sons
- Joseph travels the 3 days from Hebron to Shechem, and finds out that they have moved on. Joseph travels another day to Dothan.
- Brothers plot to kill Joseph (kill the dream by killing the dreamer).
- Brothers take the coat of Joseph.
- Reuben says, throw Joseph into this dry cistern. Reuben plans to rescue him later.
- Then the brothers eat supper. Reuben leaves.
- Judah has a new plan when he sees Ishmaelite caravan of traders. Sell Joseph into slavery for 20 pieces of silver. Joseph is taken to Egypt and sold.
- Reuben comes back. Joseph is gone. Reuben is dismayed, and tears his clothes.
- Brothers butcher a goat and spill the blood on the coat of Joseph. They take the coat back to the father and ask if it is the coat of Joseph.
- Jacob thinks Joseph has been killed by a wild animal. Jacob weeps, mourns and will not be comforted.

Lessons learned:

- Do not show favoritism.
- Jealousy comes from discontent.
- Deal with jealousy and envy when they first rear their heads.
- Jealousy and envy are sins and are not harmless. They destroy relationships and destroy people.
- Love is not jealous, does not envy (1 Cor. 13:4).
- All betrayal hurts.
- Jesus was betrayed. He has been where you are.
- Step deeper into your relationship with God.
- Jesus said, "Father, forgive them."
- Lean not on our own understanding.
- The story of Joseph is about God working through the everyday events of life.
- No miracles, but the hidden hand of God.
