

2. SPORTS DISCIPLINES AND COURSE SEAT VACANCIES:

Initially, the course will be conducted in the following sports disciplines:

- i. Athletics
- ii. Boxing
- iii. Hockey
- iv. Judo
- v. Wrestling

Seat Intake: Minimum 10 and maximum 20 candidates per discipline per batch.

Note:

1. In case of more than twenty candidates in one sport discipline, Candidates will be selected on the basis of ranking as follows: -

- First: Medal in Olympics.
- Second: Medal in Senior World Championships.
- Third: Participation in Olympics.
- Fourth: Medal in Asian/Commonwealth Games
- Fifth: Participation in Senior World Championship

2. In case of Score tie (within the same discipline), admission will be given to the candidates who is elder in age.

8. Important Points for the Attention of the candidates:

1. The candidates, before submitting the online application, shall ensure their eligibility for the course.
2. Applications of candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria shall be rejected.
3. Online application cannot be withdrawn once it is submitted successfully.
4. Request for change in any particular in the application shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
5. Admission of a candidate to the course is provisional subject to being found medically fit and verification of educational and sports certificates.
6. In case a candidate is found providing incorrect information or identity is proved to be false or certificates found fake at any time even after the start/end of the course, the candidate will be terminated/disqualified and shall face penal action as per law.
7. The name on the photo identification card must match with the name as in the application submitted. If the name has been changed due to marriage or due to any other reasons, candidate must show the relevant document (in original) at the time of exam. (Marriage Certificate /Divorce/Degree /Legal Name Change Document)
8. Sports specific merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in respect of sports achievement.
9. Provisional Merit list (Sports specific) of the candidates will be displayed on NSNIS website www.nsnis.org.
10. Candidates selected provisionally have to bring with them medical fitness certificates issued by the Medical Officer of Government Hospital of their respective/nearby area.
11. Selected candidates will pay the fees before the commencement of the course.
12. Non-Objection Certificate (NOC) from concerned government organisation needs to be produced and submitted to SAI NS NIS, Patiala Academic centre.
13. Boarding and lodging facilities will be subject to availability of facility at discretion of Competent Authority.
14. During each level at least 85% attendance is compulsory to appear for the exam. Further permission needs to be taken well in advance for the leave, from In-charge Academic of SAI NS NIS, Patiala.
15. In case of Score tie (within the same discipline), admission will be given to the candidates who is elder in age.

- 1. Sports Authority of India reserves the right to cancel any education programme, change the venue and also increase/decrease the duration of the course, due to administrative and other reasons.**
