Hotlines - and the Sensons

DO ANGELS SING THE BLUES?

In the following story beats, I'm also marking the IMPLIED SCENES in parentheses, as well as scenes which are not chronological. These offer possibilities for putting the implied scene on screen, or re-ordering the sequence. I'm also marking the natural acts and turning points.

Story Beats:

VOICE of THEODORE HALEY STONE in his head Mentions about writing songs with CAREY

<u>SET-UP</u> - the Meeting of Theo and James. Establish their relationship. This first scene could be a Pre-Credit Sequence, and then focus the body of the script on the Senior Year.

<u>Age 10</u>

The Stones move next door

JAMES watches soccer game/he's left out
ALLISON playing soccer
Theo comes, asks him to come with him (p. 4)
(They build a raft/police find them (p. 250)

<u>Age 12</u>

Gets guitar, father is in band (Implied scene - Show James & Theo listening to father playing?)
Sings with Theo/Takes guitar lessons

High School/Freshman Year

Theo calls - he hears Blues music (p. 10)
Listen to BOOGIE MAN, call James "Boog"
They start their own band (w/ DANNY & KEITH)
Have 1st gig at an 8th grade graduation party (p. 12)

ACT ONE - Set-Up

They find a name for their band - Blues Thing (p. 15)
They win Yardley Beach Club Jamboree
Win 500 bumper stickers with their band's name
(Imply on-going image of these bumper stickers in various states of disrepair throughout the script - a running gag)
Mentions funeral, mentions Theo in his head/hasn't played
(Implied relationship with SHARON)
(Implied on-going dislike of NATALIE)

High School/Senior Year

Meets Carey in Brockmeyer's class (p. 20-21)

Carey demonstrates low self-esteem (p. 23) Natalie sees Carey (p. 30) Spends money on guitar collection (p. 36) (Est. specific love of certain guitars) Theo and James go on ice route They practice in garage (p. 39) James applies to music school (p. 40) Mother established as journalist, concerned w/rights Plant dying in kitchen (p. 47) (Could est. on-going images of dying plants - running gag) They play at Harvest Dance (p. 53) Carey takes drink of brandy Natalie, with ALLAN, confronts Carey with the truth (62) Est. Backstory of Carey In class, learn about starvation Ms. Brockmeyer asks James re CHARLIE (p. 69) Carey gives unusual answer on quiz (. 73) James to Anchor House, meets MAC WINTERS Works with Charlie (p. 80) To Carey's House, meets the BENSONS (p. 85) Have afternoon lemonade with Bensons Meet MR. HARRIGON (p. 98) They play at church (p. 100)

1st TURNING POINT

Consider making a demo tape/discuss money(p. 101) (Implied Scene - James trying to get gigs at Eastfield Country Club for Valentine's Day and the Factory) (Implied Scene - combine all this into need for demo tape for big contest mentioned on p. 184. If the contest were mentioned here, this could be an excellent 1st T.P.)

DANNY mentions need for original songs (p. 102)
Carey writes "Midnight Magic" (p. 104)
James tells Charlie he's busy
Charlie comes to James' house/meets ALLIE (p. 107)
On test, Carey writes Yeats again (p. 117)
Band asked to do Natalie's Party (p. 119)
At party, conflict with Natalie/Carey asked to leave
Theo follows her, doesn't return/they don't get paid
Allison and Mom have a fight (p. 125)
James has a fight with Theo (p. 129)
(Implied contrasting scenes of 3 fights - w/Natalie, with
Allie, with Theo)

MIDPOINT SCENE

Carey calls, they go to Devil's Hollow (p. 135)
Have a picnic, hear the music (p. 138)
(Notice - this is a kind of an epiphany scene. This could be done quite beautifully, perhaps as a midpoint scene)
Carey completes "Midnight Magic" song for James (p. 141)
(Implied M.P. scene since this is when Carey, in a sense,

"joins" the group by adding original music and giving the group a better chance at the contest.)

December, blizzard, Allie and Charlie want to tobaggon (Implied scenes - Allie talking on phone w/Charlie) (Implied Scene - making demo tape) They go to Bensons to tobaggon, have cocoa (p. 148) At Christmas, Charlie going home, says good-bye Goes back to Anchor House to give guitar for Charlie (158) Goes to Stones' Christmas Party (p. 162) ELLEN and ERIC home - Carey drunk (p. 164) Mentions Natalie was there, sings carols (Implied scene - Natalie there when James is there, or James arrives as conflict erupts.) Carey bumps table, drunk (p. 166)

Jan-February, Valentine's Day dance (p. 171)

Carey dances with another guy, leaves with him (p. 173) James talks to his father Carey calls (p. 179) HEADHUNTER announces contest, need for demo (p. 188) They practice. Carey late for class - no late pass. Brockmeyer finds her vodka, Theo lies for her (p. 191)

2nd TURNING POINT

Theo grounded, no band (p. 193) They talk about splitting up the band (p. 197) Carey calls about Mrs. Benson James gets Dr. Stone/she leaves in ambulance (Implied Scene - what done with Mr. Benson) (Implied Scene - it might be that this problem causes the need to have Benson's children move back in, and Harrigan's have to leave. It was unclear in the book whether Bensons had children - but this could work. might be able to reorder some scenes a bit, since the need to move of Harrigans is a good 2nd Turning Point on this subplot line.) Band has to change because of Theo (p. 109) Can't play in contest, demo tape made - ruined by Theo. James has talk with Allie (p. 212) James is accepted to college (p. 213) (Implied Throughline about Saab, getting worse and worse and giving out about this time) Carey is flunking/won't graduate (p. 213) Natalie mentions the new job for Doc (p. 215) Natalie mentions she's going to Wellesley, Theo to B.U. They go to Hollow to celebrate beautiful day Theo jumps (p. 220) Carey cries (p. 222) Have farewell engagement after Senior Prom (p. 223) Carey not around (p. 224) Allie reports that man back, Charlie perhaps in danger Gets news about Carey's father, arrested (p. 232)

Goes to Carey's house/Benson knocking - Fire (p. 235)

CLIMAX

Mrs. Benson and Theo die, Carey runs (p. 240)

RESOLUTION

At funeral parlor/Carey comes (p. 247)
James runs away (p. 248)
Mentions rafting when 10
Charlie hurt, he called Carey, she calls
Goes to hospital, sees Charlie (p. 255)
Carey had called from Anchor House
James offers one of their bedrooms (p. 258)
Gets crate from Stones - a harp (p. 261)
He knows it must go to Carey
He got the harp, his voice is back, it's a sign (262)
(Implied through image re harp. Imply more about theme of looking for a sign)
