Charitable Purpose for Brecon Pride:

To promote equality and diversity for the public benefit and in particular the elimination of discrimination on the grounds of sexual orientation or gender identity, including in particular but not exclusively by:

- *Raising awareness of the public with regard to all aspects of discrimination in society and issues and difficulties affecting the lives Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex and Asexual people plus those of other sexual orientations, gender identities or expression, and sex characteristics (LGBTQIA+).*
- *Cultivating a sentiment in favour of equality and diversity, in particular through celebrating the achievements of LGBTQIA+ people and the diversity of the LGBTQIA+ community.*
- *Staging and promoting LGBTQIA+ events, and in particular, an annual LGBTQIA+ PRIDE event.*
- *Promoting activities to foster understanding between people from diverse backgrounds.*
- *Advancing education and raising awareness in equality and diversity, whether by teaching, interaction, performance or producing and/or displaying artistic and other materials.*

- **Support** – Create an inclusive and welcoming environment where everyone can feel safe, valued, and respected.
- **Listen** – Actively listen to and amplify the voices of LGBTQIA+ individuals, recognising their experiences and challenges.
- **Challenge** – Speak up against discrimination, prejudice, and inequality, ensuring that our community remains a space of dignity and respect for all.
- **Learn** – Continually learn about LGBTQIA+ identities and issues.
- **Affirm** – Proactively support transgender people by respecting their identities, using correct names and pronouns, and advocating for their rights and dignity throughout society.
- **Respect** – Not bring Brecon Pride into disrepute.
