# Saint Dwynwen's Tale



Dwynwen is Wales' patron saint of lovers. She lived on Anglesey in the 5th century. She was said to be the most beautiful of King Brychan Brycheiniog's 24 daughters.

Dwynwen fell in love with a man named Maelon Dafodrill, and intended to marry him. However her father had already arranged for her to be married to someone else. Upon hearing this news, Maelon became so enraged that he attacked Dwynwen.

In her grief, Dwynwen fled to the forest. There she prayed to be able to forget her love for Maelon. In time she fell asleep, and in her sleep she was visited by an angel. The angel offered her a potion that would make her forget Maelon and would also turn him to ice.

Dwynwen prayed for three wishes. The first was for Maelon not to be frozen, the second was to secure the happiness of lovers, and the third was that she should never be married.

Her wishes were granted and in gratitude she dedicated her life to God, becoming a nun, and establishing her own church on the isle of Llanddwyn. She died there in 460AD.

The name Llanddwyn derives from the words Llan + Dwyn, literally meaning the Church of Santes Dwynwen.
