

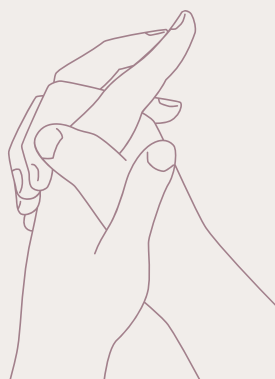
GRACE MULLEN
