You can't reinforce fear! If your pet needs a stroke for reassurance then give them some love!



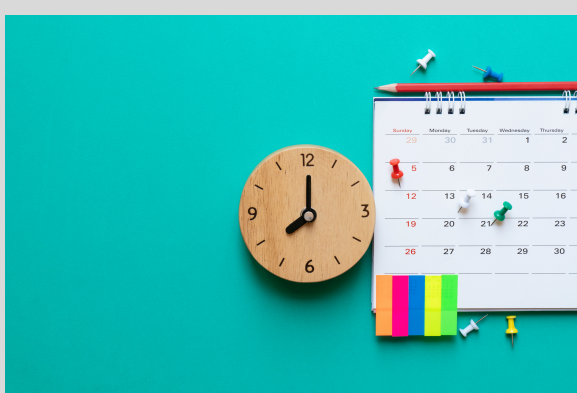
