Millbrae Teen Center

Middle school students have an after school location they can call their own! The Teen Center was opened at the Rec Center in January 2008 and it serves an average of 25 students per day. Teens can choose from ping pong, pool, Nintendo Wii, participating in a basketball tournament, and arts and crafts. MCF funding will help keep the doors open for our middle school students.

Second Harvest Food Bank

MCF provided funding to support Millbrae Seniors Brown Bag Program. This program provides a weekly bag of groceries to low-income seniors and disabled individuals (ages 55 or more) in Millbrae. This program for seniors is run by seniors, and is vitally important in our community as our seniors benefit both nutritionally and socially from the program.
