Neighbor to Neighbor

Renovation plans are being developed for the Millbrae Lions Club Scout House located on the Taylor Middle School property. The Scout House, now referred to as the Millbrae Community Youth Center, was constructed in 1954 but has since fallen into disrepair and is no longer used. A group of residents and civic leaders have joined together to raise about \$250,000 by January 2012. MCF has set up a designated fund in support of this special project.

The renovation is a joint effort of the Millbrae Lions Club, the Millbrae Elementary School District and the City of Millbrae, and is supported by groups like the Rotary and Soroptomists. Volunteers from the Central Peninsula Church of Millbrae, Lions, Leos, and Kohl's store performed an initial clean up in March. Additional in-kind labor and services are needed.

The Millbrae Community Youth Center will be used for a variety of youth and civic programs and will provide an additional meeting room for our community. For more information, contact Denis Fama at dennyduz@aol.com.
