Smart Boards for All Classrooms at Lomita Park: Partnering with Rotary Club

The Rotary Club of Millbrae set an ambitious goal: replace outdated whiteboards and chalkboards with interactive **smart boards** in every classroom and the library at Lomita Park School—a Title I school serving some of Millbrae's most deserving students. The \$52,000 project was funded through a combination of a Rotary District 5150 grant, Millbrae Rotary Club funds, and generous private donations.

MCF was proud to serve as the financial partner in this effort, collecting and stewarding donor contributions before distributing the funds to the Millbrae Elementary School District to complete the purchase. It's exactly the kind of community collaboration MCF was built for—and the students and teachers of Lomita Park School will benefit for years to come.
