
# Service and Maintenance


#### **Keeping you compliant**

We are often asked, 'Why do we need our hard of hearing system serviced, and is it the law to have it serviced? Our answer to this is; 'There is no law that says you must have your system serviced.' However, it is unlawful (Equality Act 2010) to put a hearing impaired person at a disadvantage if the loop system is not performing to BS EN 60118-4:2015.

#### **Annual servicing**

All employers, service providers and public buildings have to make reasonable adjustments to improve the accessibility of their service for disabled customers and staff. A failure to make reasonable adjustments results in discrimination against disabled persons. We offer annual servicing (recommended in BS 7594:2011) or ad-hoc maintenance for all hard of hearing and audio systems.





#### **Training your staff**

Once your system has been installed, we provide training for your staff on how to use the system and make regular system checks. We recommend a trained member of staff checks the system weekly and logs the test results, as well as having an Annual Service. We also train staff on how to deal with issues hearing aid users may face. In the event that the system isn't working properly, always contact us as soon as you can.

#### What we do:

- Issue a Certificate of Conformity per system
- Provide training on how to use the system
- Provide clear instruction manuals
- Provide signage indicating a system is installed
- Report on faults and provide quotes for repairs
- Provide telephone support
