Do <u>empower</u> kids to envision a healthier, cleaner, and more equitable world.

how to embrace and hold the uncertainty of the climate era.





Do support kids in embracing
& responding to difficult facts and uncertainties of our world.

burning coal, oil, and gas, gender & racial oppression, colonization, inequality & injustice, and how individual choices ripple out to spur system change.

Do use a harm reduction approach and balance difficult facts with agency, imagination, & conversation.

Do use all senses: music, art, poetry, time in nature, food, dance, etc. These all help kids stay engaged while learning.

Don't... be silent





Don't present problems as intractable. Kids need to know adults care and are taking action.

Don't perpetuate messages of doom and gloom.

No 'Doomerism'.





Don't withhold tough information. With <u>support</u> kids can handle the truth.

Don't perpetuate racist or fossil fuel polluter narratives, such as population or individuals as a main problem or the main solution in causing or addressing climate change.

Don't present traumatic climate info before about 3rd grade and don't share too much information at once. Kids can't learn outside the Window of Tolerance.
