(legendary and storied living spaces)

This ki'i (picture) shows an ahupua'a (land division), where wai (water) flows from mauka (mountain) to makai (ocean), connecting 'āina (land), people, and kai (sea). Use the word bank to label the ki'i and follow the journey of wai. Circle something we should protect and mark an "X" next to something that could impact our wai. Hint: Look for what comes from the mountains, what lives or grows along the way, and what may affect the wai. Think about how everything is connected and what your kuleana is in caring for this place.
