- E. \$800 Sponsor one practicum placement - Tax Receipt, Recognition

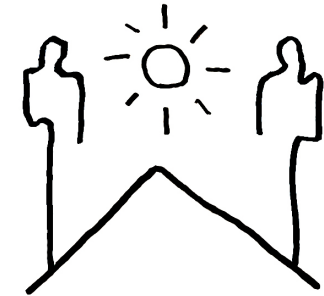
