


We host people who are traveling through, various types of professionals, sports spectators, and people who grew up here and need a place when they come home for events or to see family.

JALAPENO-CHEDDAR CORN MUFFINS



This recipe has quickly become one of my family's favorites. It pairs perfectly with rotisserie or bbq chicken, creamed potatoes, and green beans.

Be careful! You'll have trouble eating just one!

Ingredients

- Cooking spray
- Jalapeño peppers, 2 medium
- Uncooked sweet yellow corn, 1½ cup(s)
- Yellow cornmeal, 1 cup
- All-purpose flour, 1/3 cup
- Sugar, 1 Tbsp
- Baking powder, ¾ tsp
- Table salt, ½ tsp
- Baking soda, ¼ tsp
- Plain fat free Greek yogurt, ¾ cup
- Canola oil, 2 Tbsp
- Egg(s), 2 large eggs, lightly beaten
- Reduced fat sharp cheddar cheese made

with 2% milk, ¾ cup(s), shredded, shredded

Directions:

Fresh corn provides sweetness and crunch in these corn muffins, while reduced-fat cheddar enriches them with savory goodness. You could also use canned corn for similar crunch if fresh isn't available or at its peak.

The jalapeño slices that top the muffins cue folks in on the flavor profile, but you can just chop all of the peppers and stir them into the batter. For a little heat, leave the seeds in half of a pepper; for more, leave them in one whole pepper or both of them.


