CCW QUALIFICATION COURSE INFORMATION

COURSE LOCATION:

The course will run from 0830 hours to approximately 1700 hours (8:30am-5:00pm). Students will first meet 0830 at the designated training location announced via email for check in and class. After completion of the classroom portion of the course, students will go to the designated range location for the range portion of the course.

Courses are presently being held in Santa Maria, CA.

DESCRIPTION:

Course Focus:

The CCW Qualification Course is focused on the attitude, knowledge, and skills needed for carrying a concealed weapon. The class covers good moral character, legal concerns, safety and liability, and has discussion and scenarios. There is a heavy emphasis on legal and civil responsibility as well as interacting with law enforcement. Safe firearm handling and written testing will occur.

Course Requirements:

You must bring:

- Laptop or method of note taking. I highly recommend a laptop.
- All the firearms that will be on your CCW permit.
- Enough ammunition for the course:
 - Minimum of 100 rounds if you reside in SLO County.
 - Minimum of 200 rounds if you reside in Santa Barbara County.
 - Additional ammo to qualify with each firearm (50 rounds per firearm).
- Clothing appropriate for concealed carry.
- Proper range equipment: Eye protection, Ear protection, Firearm Holster, Magazine Holster, Magazines (3 required, but recommend 4).

STANDARD CAPACITY MAGAZINES ARE ALLOWED AND ENCOURAGED!

BRING A HOLSTER OR CARRY METHOD FOR EACH GUN: It is a requirement for the course of fire that you must have a holster or other carry method and know how to properly use it. If you do not have one, send us an email and I will help you find one that is acceptable. Central Coast Tactical is a dealer and able to assist with getting you equipment, accessories, ammunition, and more.

The qualification will happen immediately after class at approximately 1600 hours. You are expected to be prepared to qualify with properly functioning equipment and firearms. If you have issues with equipment or your firearms contact us prior to the start of the course so we can assist you.

YARDS	ROUNDS	INSTRUCTIONS
3 yards	2 rounds	Draw and fire 2 rounds at Center Mass in 7 seconds.
5 yards	3 rounds	Draw and fire 2 rounds at Center Mass and 1 round to the head in 10 seconds.
5 yards	3 rounds	Draw and fire 2 rounds at Center Mass and 1 round to the head in 10 seconds.
5 yards	3 rounds	Draw and fire 2 rounds at Center Mass and 1 round to the head in 10 seconds.
7 yards	4 rounds	Draw and fire 2 rounds to one target and 2 rounds to an adjacent target in 15 seconds.
10 yards	3 rounds	Draw and fire 3 rounds at center mass in 15 seconds.
10 yards	3 rounds	Draw and fire 3 rounds at center mass in 15 seconds.
15 yards	3 rounds	Draw and fire 3 rounds at center mass in 20 seconds.

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CCW QUALIFICATION COURSE OF FIRE

YARDS	ROUNDS	INSTRUCTIONS
3 yards	5 rounds	On command, student fires 5 rounds. (No time limit)
3 yards	5 rounds	On command, student fires 5 rounds with their strong hand unsupported. (No time limit)
5 yards	5 rounds	On command, student fires 5 rounds. (No time limit)
5 yards	5 rounds	On command, student fires 5 rounds in 30 seconds.
5 yards	10 rounds	On command, student fires 5 rounds, reloads and fires 5 rounds in 2 minutes.
7 yards	10 rounds	On command, student fires 10 rounds. (No time limit)
10 yards	10 rounds	On command, student fires 5 rounds in 60 seconds. Repeat.
