## **NRA CCW w/ QUALIFICATION CLASS INFORMATION**

### **COURSE LOCATION:**

The NRA CCW Class will run from 0830 hours to approximately 1700 hours (8:30am-5:00pm). Students will first meet at First Defense Firearms at 0830 for check in and class. After completion of the classroom portion of the course, students will go to SLOSA for the range portion of the course.

First Defense Firearms: 1191 Los Osos Valley Rd, Los Osos, CA.

San Luis Obispo Sportsmen's Association: 3270 Gilardi Rd, San Luis Obispo, CA.  
The SLOSA range is located off of Highway 1 just south of Morro Bay.

### **DESCRIPTION:**

#### Course Focus:

The CCW Qualification Course is focused on the attitude, knowledge, and skills needed for carrying a concealed weapon. The class covers good moral character, legal concerns, safety and liability, and has discussion and scenarios. There is a heavy emphasis on legal and civil responsibility as well as interacting with law enforcement. Safe firearm handling and written testing will occur.

#### Course Requirements:

You must bring:

- Laptop or method of note taking. Highly recommend a laptop.
- All the firearms that will be on your CCW permit.
- Enough ammunition for the class, minimum of 100 rounds.
- Additional ammo to qualify with each firearm (24 rounds per firearm).
- Clothing appropriate for concealed carry.
- Proper range equipment: Eye protection, Ear protection, Firearm Holster, Magazine Holster, Magazines (3 required, but recommend 4). Standard "high-capacity" magazines are allowed and encouraged.

Range Qualification will happen immediately after class at approximately 1600 hours. You are expected to be prepared to qualify with properly functioning equipment and firearms. If you have issues with equipment or your firearms contact us prior to the start of the course so you can be assisted.

If equipment or firearms are needed, contact or go to First Defense Firearms. Phone #: 805-528-4867. Discounts are available if enrolled in a CCW Course.

A short lunch break will be around 1200 hours. There will be some time available if you need to drive into town to get food. However, it is recommended to bring a sack lunch.

### **CCW QUALIFICATION COURSE OF FIRE**

**DESCRIPTION OF COURSE:** This course will be fired in 5 stages. After each portion of the course, the shooter will be allowed to reload magazines/speed loaders etc. to prepare for the next phase of the qualification.

**Stage I** - 3 yards - 2 rounds - Draw and fire 2 rounds at Center Mass in 7 seconds

**Stage II** - 5 yards - 9 rounds - Draw and fire 2 rounds at Center Mass and 1 round to the head in 10 seconds (x3)

**Stage III** - 7 yards - 4 rounds - Draw and fire 2 rounds to one target and 2 rounds to an adjacent target in 15 seconds

**Stage IV** - 10 yards - 6 rounds - Draw and fire 3 rounds at center mass in 15 seconds (X2)

**Stage V** - 15 yards. - 3 rounds - Draw and fire 3 rounds at center mass in 20 seconds

**NOTE:** Reloads will be conducted as needed with all magazines loaded to capacity at the beginning of the course of fire.

**PRACTICE SOME BEFOREHAND IF NEEDED (CCW PREP COURSE AVAILABLE)**

**BRING A HOLSTER OR CARRY METHOD FOR EACH GUN:** It is a requirement for the qualification course of fire that you must have a holster or other carry method and know how to properly use it. If you do not have an appropriate carry method on the day of the class, you will not be able to qualify on the day of the class.

If you do not have one, send us an email and I will help you find one that is acceptable or contact First Defense Firearms for additional assistance with equipment.
