

First Interstate Schoolboy match

Queensland Times (Ipswich, Qld. : 1909 - 1954), Thursday 15 August 1912

This was a most interesting engagement between the youths of the two States, being the first school grade representative match, played under "soccer" codes in Australia. The ground was under water, consequently the ball became very heavy and greasy.

The first half terminated in favour of the New South Wales boys, they having gained 3 goals to their opponents 1. This half was marked by distinctly good play, J. M'Gill (of the Ipswich Central State School and P. Statham (of the Dinmore School) being frequently prominent

The second term was, however, responsible of brilliant expositions on both sides, the Southern boys giving a really attractive display. Shortly after the ball was put in motion, the New South Welsh boys gained their No. 4 goal. From this out, the Queenslanders warmed up, and their efforts were warmly applauded. Shirras the Queensland goalie, gave another attractive exhibition in goal. The following are the names of the players

The game ended--New South Wales, 4 goals; Queensland, 1.

Schoolboys Involved In Brisbane's Worst Crash of Kind

BRISBANE, July 26.—Brisbane's worst bus and tram collision, in which both vehicles were almost totally destroyed by fire, occurred at Woolloongabba at 5.10 p.m. to-day and resulted in 24 persons being admitted to hospital.

The bus, carrying the New South Wales and Queensland schoolboy Soccer players, was city bound from Wynnum when it swerved into an outbound Balmoral tram in Stanley-street, near the Woolloongabba railway yards. Thrown on its side the bus immediated burst into flames which also engulfed the front cabin of the tram.

The schoolboys, some cut and burned, poured from the blazing bus through the front door and rear window, but several people were trapped in the tram cabin.

Shocking scenes were witnessed as men and women, some burnt almost beyond recognition, rolled and screamed on the roadway in agony. Two fire reels, seven ambulance cars and dozens of police arrived within a few minutes, and the ambulances and taxis maintained a shuttle service to both the Mater and General hospitals.
