
William(Pop) Dann (-1989)

William had six sons play soccer, four represented Ipswich during their careers All were Queensland Representatives at schoolboy level and three at Senior level

William represented Ipswich in 1934 in a McGregor Cup match. Bill originally played rugby league for Ipswich All-Sports Rugby League Club.



But as a father he felt soccer was the better code for his boys to play and as an example he quickly changed jerseys and donned his soccer boots.

In those days he played with Oxley United and later Redbank Seekers many time with his eldest son Noel.

William became a Life Member of St Helens

Each of the Dann boys have in their own way achieved success. Some have gone on to represent Ipswich in junior and senior soccer Kevin(3) Douglas, Jeffrey(4) John(8) Stephen(2) played Kruger Cup for Ipswich

Bill (Junior) come through the junior ranks and also having made the Ipswich team as a schoolboy.

John, Stephen and Jeffrey went on to even greater heights to represent Queensland
John was selected to play for Queensland against South Australia in 1973 and the squad for Birmingham City
Stephen was selected in 1971 squad against Sydney Hakoah and in 1975 the squad against Manchester United
Jeffrey represented Queensland against Wisla Kracow, Norwich City and was in the squad against New Caledonia in 1979

Club achievements

Noel played for Redbank Seekers and his son Rodney was a Qld Junior representative

Kevin played in the 1967 Ampol Cup winning team for St Helens

John was runner up in the Rothmans Medal in 1976

John, Stephen and Jeffrey were in the 1979 Ipswich United Ampol Cup winning team.

John was the leading goal scorer for the season

This was the first trophy for an Ipswich team since 1957

Jeffrey was the leading goal scorer for the season in 1980 and was Ipswich United's Player of the Year in 1981

John and Jeffrey were in the 1982 St Helens Grand Final winning team St Helens were approached by Lions in 1982 for John to play in their National League team but no agreement was reached

Jeffrey was selected in the State League team of the year in 1983 and he and Billy were in the Ampol Cup winning team for Ipswich United Jeffrey and Billy were in the 1984 St Helens Grand Final winning team









Noel Kevin Doug John

Bill (Junior) played Premier League and was a member of the 1982 St Helens SEQ Premiership team that was managed by Stephen Bill also coached as did John. And Jeffrey who coached Ipswich United reserve team


Stephen was also Manager of St. Helen's Ipswich United South-East Queensland League team.

Douglas a former Ipswich representative coached St. Helen's junior teams and was President of the Ipswich United Club

Kevin coached St Helen's junior teams and played for Bee Gees on the Sunshine Coast
Noel was a qualified referee, his two sons Christopher and Rodney reached representative level
Douglas son Darren was a schoolboy representative and played for Ipswich United
So overall Bill and his sons have promoted, played and supported Ipswich Soccer for nearly fifty years

Ray played Kruger Cup for Ipswich in 1969. Ray was leading goal scorer in 1971 for Bee Gees


Graham was Captain/ Coach of the Premiership winning Bee Gees on the Sunshine Coast


