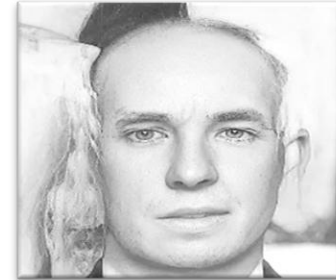

Andrew played for Dinmore Bush Rats, Brisbane Lions, Olympic and Coalstars

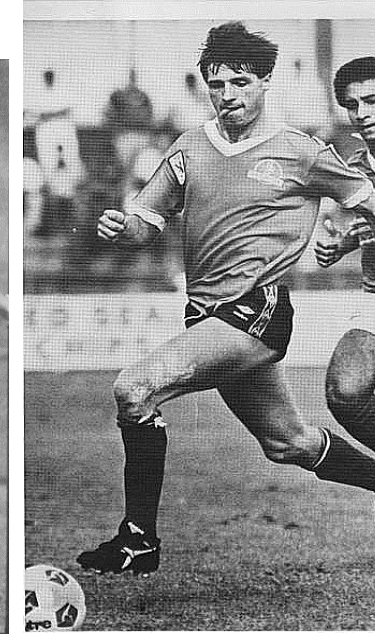

In his first year of First Division Soccer, and without having played top football for his State, Ipswich's Ian Lawrie has been selected in the Australian under 23 years team to visit Indonesia

And at 18, Ian has more than his father, Bob Lawrie, who went on to captain Australia in South Africa in 1958.

Ian left for Sydney on Monday where the team will spend a week to camp with top coach Eric Northcote, who will be assisted by former Australian World Cup captain, Robert Warren.

The team will spend two weeks in Indonesia, where it has been drawn against Indonesia and South Korea.

As a schoolboy Ian represented Ipswich and played with Coalstars in the junior grades. He moved to Ipswich in 1975 and was selected in the under 18 squad for Australia.

Last year he transferred to Ipswich City (then Ipswich) which has the same name as his father's club and played in reserve grade.

"Other players he is the captain, Peter I have never played with," he said. "He is a leader, he is a captain, he can lead a game and make it be his to play what will happen, he is a star."

Local coach, George Pagan, the man responsible for moving Ian from the Seagulls to the half-back, said he had very high hopes for Ian.

"He shows tremendous ability and versatility," Mr. Pagan said yesterday. "He is tall and very strong and I have enjoyed him in a winger role. He is a very intelligent player who reads the game well."

"At one time he needed to lose concentration if he made a mistake, but he has developed concentration and grown in confidence. There is no doubt he will go further if he maintains his confidence in the game."

Ian, who will be 18 late in October, is a star in the Ipswich and Peter Dwyer (Seagulls). He comes from a sporting family, his father having captained Australia against South Africa, England and various other teams. The coach, formerly John Roberts, captained Queensland at eight and represented Ipswich at hockey.

It is expected that Ian will get a chance to play for his State when this month when the United Australian Cricket team will be in Brisbane.
