Michael Jeffrey from Lanark Scotland marries Mary Bell Lanarkshire Scotland (1850-1925)  
They immigrate from Lanarkshire in 1870 on the SS Indus.

Michael is a future Dinmore Bush Rats President and was on the Committee that oversaw the building of the Dinmore State School in 1899.

Michael was Manager of New Chum Colliery for 36 years.

Michael will die in 1937 with his son Joe dying one month later.

Alexander, Joseph, William, Robert, Jack


William was a committee member of the West Moreton Football Association in 1893 and was Manager of the Blair Athol Colliery. His son William played for Bush Rats and served in WW1




