Billy Williams, who is well known as treasurer and providor of the Booval Bowling Club, and who spent 50 years in various mines in the Ipswich district, recalled during the week that he had scored for the Blackstone team before the old Coolgardie shaft was put down at Blackstone, prior to 1893

He was only a schoolboy then, but he can remember games being played in the Coolgardie paddock before the mine was flooded. It was necessary to build a drain across the playing field, so the late Lewis Thomas cleared another site and gave it to the sporting bodies. It was necessary to shift five houses which were erected on the creek bank and two near the railway line. Today that ground is still known as the Blackstone oval and is used for Soccer fixtures

Steady Blackstone mowed Rangers down using the west wind with more Intelligence, and playing steadier football, Blackstone Rovers sprang a real surprise on Saturday by knocking Bundamba Rangers (3-nil) from the head of the first division Soccer premiership table. St. Helens, who won their fixture, now head the table. In the opening fixture of the season Bundamba Rangers defeated Blackstone Rovers 6-ni at Blackstone. On Saturday week Rovers were down 7-nil to Thistle. The uncrushable spirit of Blackstone was evident in the way they were able to come back after those two severe reverses. Rangers were under a handicap on Saturday with the Rule brothers - Ray and Norm. - out for the fixture. and an injury early in tile second half to Spencer Kitching. if Rovers have played better positional Soccer this season than they did on Saturday.




