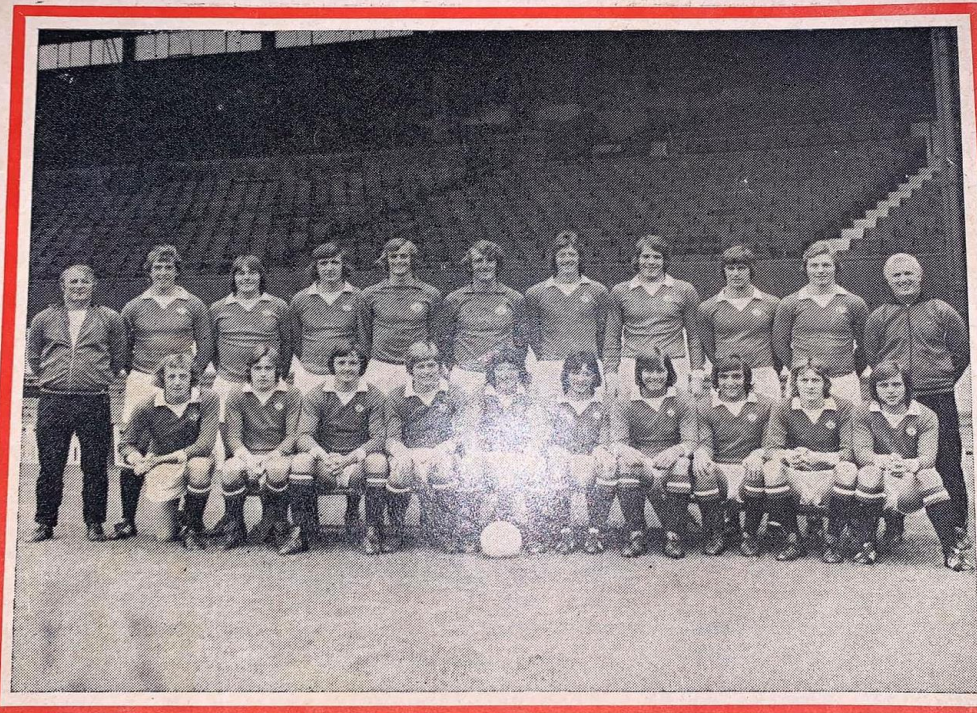

ALEX STEPNEY (Goalkeeper) - The only Londoner in the United Team. He joined the Club in September 1966 from Chelsea for a 50,000 pound fee, and has been a regular goalkeeper ever since. While playing for Millwall he became England's Under - 23 International Goalkeeper. He is an extremely agile but cool goalkeeper who won full International honours. Won a European Champion Clubs' Cup Winners' Medal in 1968. Member of the England World Cup Squad in Mexico 1970.

PADDY ROCHE (Goalkeeper) - Born Dublin. Signed October 1973 from Shelbourne Football Club. Very alert goalkeeper, good handler of the ball with excellent prospects for the future.

ALEX FORSYTH (Full-back) - Hails from Swinton in Scotland. Signed from Partick Thistle in December 1972 for a large fee; a very cool defender and a welcome asset to the side. Settled in very well. A full Scottish International capable of playing both full-back positions and also midfield.

STEWART HOUSTON (Full-back) - Formerly with Chelsea. Signed from Brentford Football Club, December 1973. A very big, quick and strong full back, and a great asset to the team.

MARTIN BUCHAN (Wing-half) - Born in Aberdeen, he became a professional with Aberdeen F.C. in 1966 at the age of 17 and joined Manchester United in February 1972 for a large transfer fee. He is a Scottish Under-23 and Full International who is very quick moving and cool under pressure and has already shown his value to his new club. Member of Scottish World Cup Squad in Munich June/July 1974.

STEVE JAMES (Centre Half) - From Brierley Hill and has the unique distinction of playing for two counties as a schoolboy and was an England Schools' Reserve. Made his first team debut v. Liverpool on 12th October 1968. A regular member of the England Youth Team in 1967/1968. During the latter part of 1970/71 season played 16 games in the first team. Made great headway in the latter part of season 1972/73, and was a regular defender until he was out of the team through injury.

PEN PICTURES CONTINUED

JIM HOLTON (Centre Half) - Born in Hamilton, Lanarkshire. A strong centre half signed from Shrewsbury Town in January 1973. Gained Scottish Under-23 and Full International Caps towards the end of season 1972/73. Regular International during season 1973/74, and member of Scottish World Cup Squad in Munich June/July 1974.

ARNOLD SIDEBOTTOM (Centre Half) - Born Barnsley and signed Amateur at 16 years of age. Signed full time professional a year later. Also a very gifted cricketer who has played for Yorkshire Cricket Club but preferred to concentrate on soccer. A strong and talented player making his first team debut at the end of season 1972/73 and continued to make good progress last season.

JIM MCCALLIOP (Mid-field) - Born Glasgow. Former Clubs were Chelsea and Sheffield Wednesday. He signed for Manchester United in March 1974 from Wolverhampton Wanderers. A quick thinking mid-field player with some deft passes. He quickly settled into the team scoring four goals in the last weeks of the season.

GEORGE GRAHAM (Half-back) - Signed from Arsenal in January 1973 for a big fee and had previously played with Aston Villa and Chelsea. A very experienced player with many Scottish International appearances. Appointed team captain for season 1973/74, taking over from Bobby Charlton.

SAMMY McILROY (Inside Forward) - Born Belfast. Played International Schools' Football (4 caps) before signing Apprentice Professional in August 1969. First team debut 6th November 1971 v Manchester City in local 'derby' at 17 years of age. Won full cap for Northern Ireland at Hull v. Spain early 1971. Made several appearances in the first team season 1971/72. A road accident in early 1973 held up his progress but is now fully fit. Became regular member of 1st team pool during past season and made great headway.

BRIAN KIDD (Inside Forward) - Manchester born and went to the same school, St.Patrick's, Collyhurst, as Nobby Stiles. England Schoolboy honours and also played for the International Youth Team. Was a big success on United's Tour "Down Under" in 1967 and gained several Under-23 International honours. After a spell in the reserves during season 1968/69 he came back to show his old form and played in many League and Cup games and gained full International Honours during Season 1969/70. Member of the World Cup Squad in Mexico 1970.

STUART PEARSON (Forward) - Born Hull. A big strong forward, signed from Hull City at the end of Season 1973/74 and expected to be a big asset to the team during Season 1974/75.

PEN PICTURES CONTINUED

WILLY MORGAN (Outside Right) - Made his First Division debut against Sheffield Wednesday at Hillsborough in April 1963 aged 18. Native of Sauchie, near Alloa, he gained full International Honours for Scotland against Northern Ireland in Belfast. Recalled for duty with the Scottish team for the Mini-World Cup in Brazil, June 1972. Had very good 1972/73 and 1973/74 seasons and became a regular Scottish International. Member of Scottish World Cup Party in Munich June/July 1974 and took over team captaincy from George Graham during last season.

TONY YOUNG (Inside Forward/Full Back) - Signed Apprentice Professional July 1968 after playing for Manchester and Lancashire County Schoolboys. Local Boy. Signed full-time professional in Dec. 1969. Went on tour to the U.S.A. with the First Team in 1970 and played in the First Division matches on several occasions during season 1971/72 making his debut on 3rd April 1972 v Sheffield United (Away). Made excellent progress in 1972/73 season after transferring to the full-back position but also played occasionally in midfield.

TREVOR ANDERSON (Left Wing) - Born Belfast and signed from Portadown in October 1972. A very promising and talented player who gained full international recognition in the British Championship games at the end of season 1972/73 and who is expected to challenge strongly for a first team place in the future.

MICK MARTIN (Midfield) - Born Dublin and signed for United from Bohemians in January 1973. Quickly came into the first team and held his place with some very good performances. Eire International who fitted in well, scoring a couple of vital goals in the struggle against relegation season 1972/73. Made several appearances in the first team during season 1973/74. A regular member of Eire International Team.

GERRY DALY (Inside Forward) - Signed from Bohemians in April 1973 and made his first team debut against Bari in the Anglo-Italian League. A very promising player, Eire International. Came into the First team during season 1973/74 and has a very promising future.

LOU MACARI (Forward) - Born Edinburgh, Scotland. Signed from Glasgow Celtic in January 1973, making his debut for United against West Ham United on the 20th January 1973 and scored a goal. Full Scottish International who played in the British Championships and was a member of the Scottish International Squad for their games in the close season.

WELCOME TO MANCHESTER UNITED

It is my pleasure to bid welcome once again to Manchester United to Brisbane for the second time and to Perry Park for the first time. I remember the first visit particularly well as this was the year I became President of the Q.S.F. which is now over nine years ago. It was very gratifying to me when Manchester United drew the largest crowd ever to a soccer game in Queensland (35,000).

Manchester defeated us that time but since then the Queensland team has improved considerably and I have it on good authority that we will be a tougher nut to crack this time.

This year we have already welcomed some big name teams from overseas, but I believe that Manchester United has a special place in the minds of the Brisbane Soccer fraternity and my welcome to our visitors will be supported by many.

Ninety minutes on the field today will give us the answer and I can look forward to entertaining our visitors after the game when I hope to be able to say "I told you so".
