Norman's son Earlston played for Dinmore Bush Rats

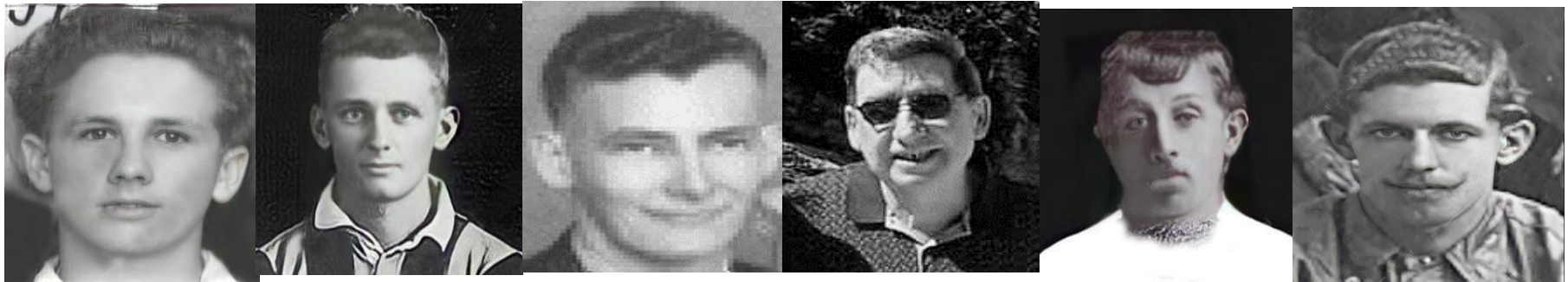
Grandson Henry Walter plays for Bush Rats and becomes Patron of the club.
