First Interstate Schoolboy match

Queensland Times (Ipswich, Qld. : 1909 - 1954), Thursday 15 August 1912

This was a most interesting engagement between the youths of the two States, being the first school grade representative match, played under "soccer" codes in Australia. The ground was under water, consequently the ball became very heavy and greasy.

The first half terminated in favour of the New South Wales boys, they having gained 3 goals to their opponents 1. This half was marked by distinctly good play, J. M'Gill (of the Ipswich Central State School and P. Statham (of the Dinmore School) being frequently prominent

The second term was, however, responsible of brilliant expositions on both sides, the Southern boys giving a really attractive display. Shortly after the ball was put in motion, the New South Welsh boys gained their No. 4 goal. From this out, the Queenslanders warmed up, and their efforts were warmly applauded. Shirras the Queensland goalie, gave another attractive exhibition in goal. The following are the names of the players

Queensland boys: In goal, Shirras ; backs, R. Whiteman and W. M'Donnell; half-backs, Cairns. L. Lindsay, Barnes: forwards, J. M'Gill (Ipswich), Leahy, P. Statham (Dinmore), Hay, and Nesbit.

The game ended--New South Wales, 4 goals; Queensland, 1.

GORDON (BUNNY) NUNN, of Ebbw Vale, is the season's goal-kicking champion. Playing for Bundamba School in the Ipswich and West Moreton Primary Schools' Soccer premiership, he kicked no fewer than 48 goals in the season of 10 matches.

THE brilliant 18-year-old St. Helen's soccer centre forward, Gordon Nunn, inherited his fondness for the round ball code from his father, who played outside right for Bundamba Rangers.

In his knickerbocker days, Gordon was taught to drive the ball into an imaginary net with uncanny accuracy from the most difficult angles.

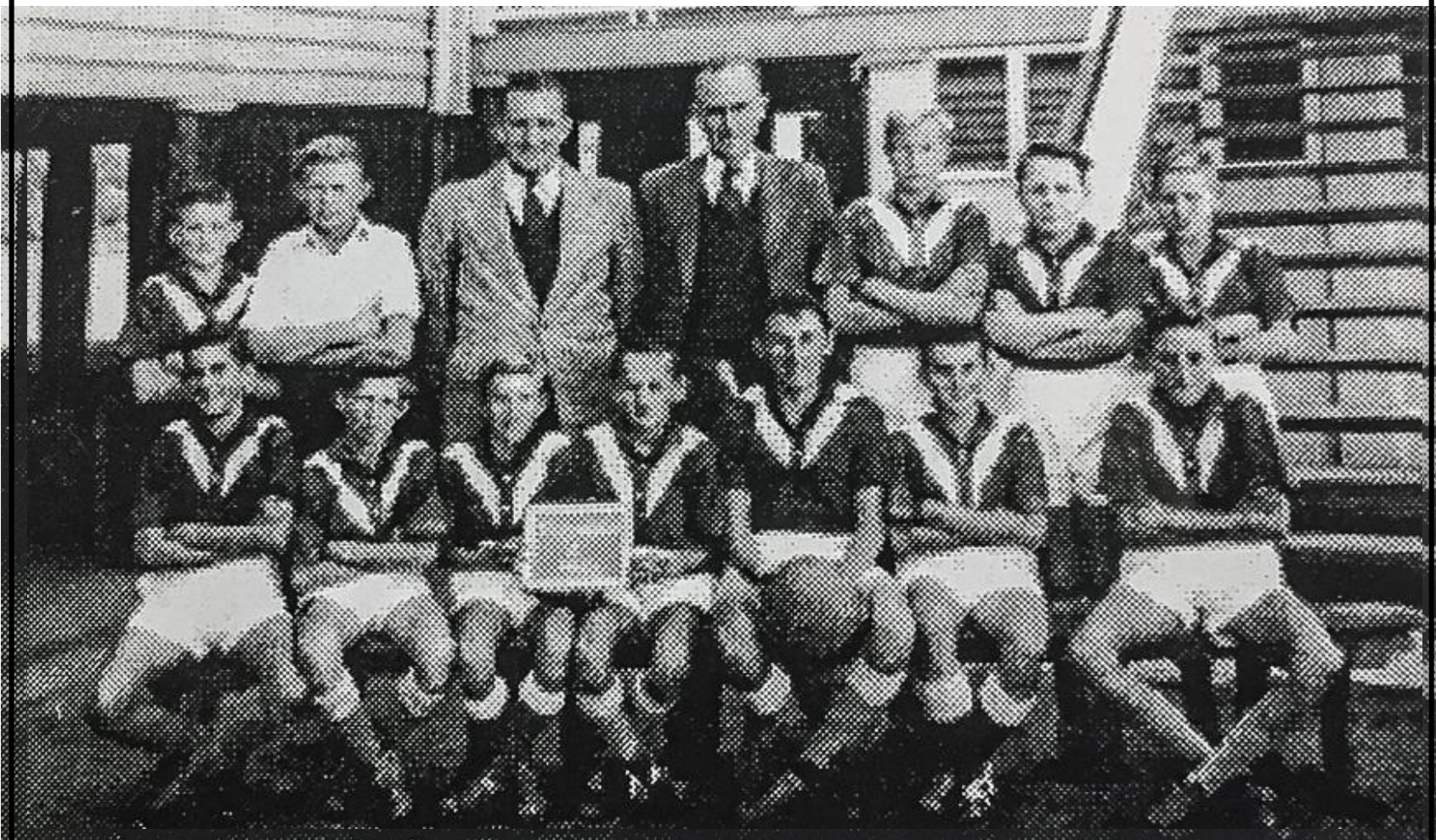

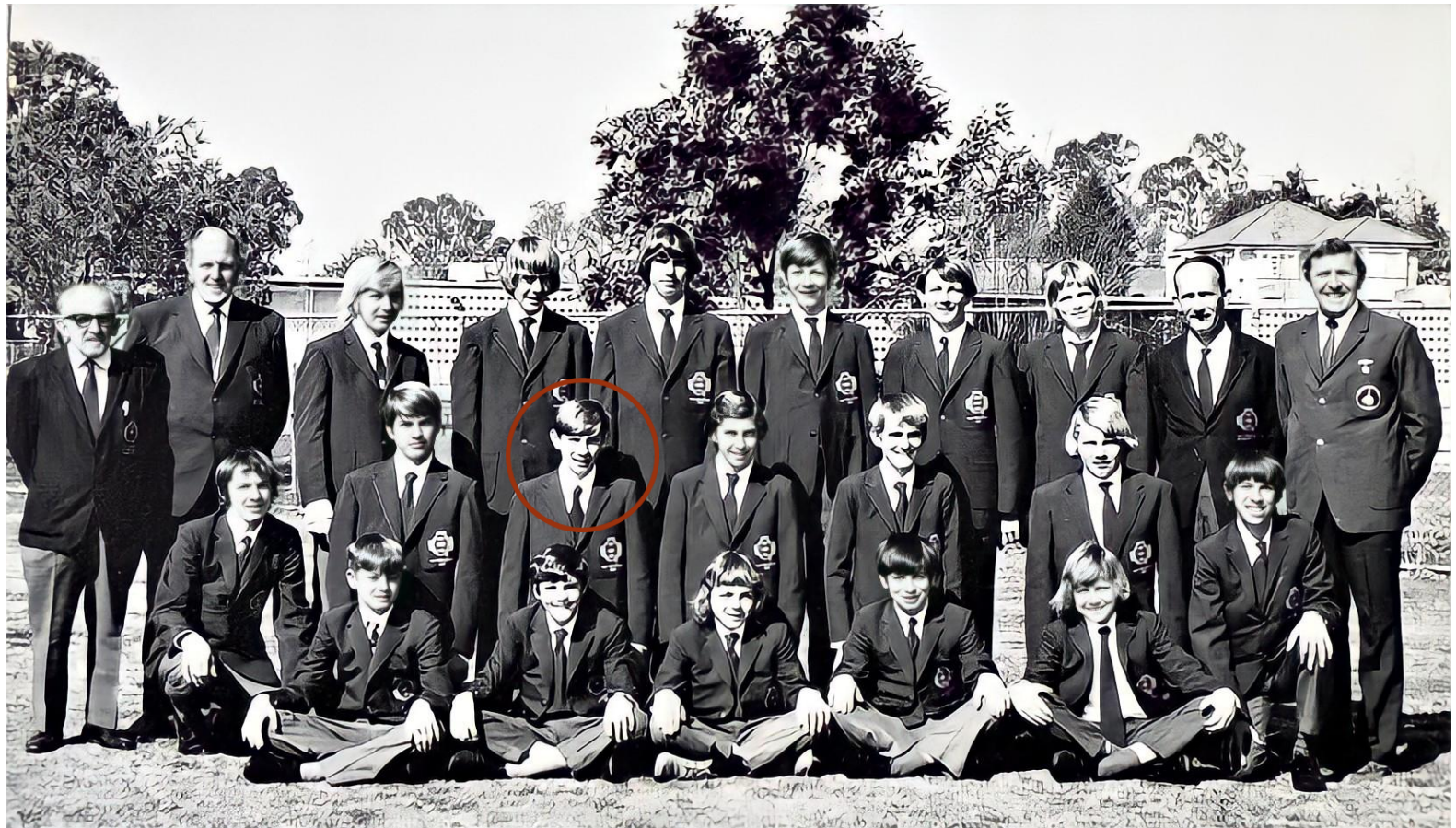
