Rich prize for Soccer

After a lapse of 13 years, Brisbane junior Soccer players will compete this season for one of the most valuable football trophies in Australia.

It is the James Stewart Shield, worth about £150, and presented to the Brisbane Junior Soccer Football Association in 1930 by its patron, Mr. James Stewart, formerly of Brisbane, and who now lives in Melbourne.

Mr. Reg. Mullins, of Coorparoo, who has been looking after the trophy as Mr. Stewart's nominee, said yesterday that he believed the Stewart Shield was the most valuable field sports trophy in Australia with the exception of cricket's Sheffield Shield.

JAMES STEWART OBITUARY
The James Stewart Shield, presented to the Brisbane Junior Football Association (Soccer).

The shield was designed and manufactured by Mr. James Stewart, who is president and chairman of committees of the Brisbane Junior Football Association. It is considered to be one of the most trophies to be competed for on the football fields of the Commonwealth. As only Queensland metals, timber, and minerals are used, it should prove in its class, a good advertisement for the State's resources.

Its measurements are 3ft by 2ft and it is enclosed in a maple case, 4ft 2in by 2ft 8in. It is of polished silver-plate, and the overlay on shield is 2lb bronze copper. The ornamental leaf scrolls in centre are of oxidised silver, and the centre plate is an engraved and coloured football scene. The ribbon with the name of the association is 1 1/2in long by 1/4in, and the overall weight is 1lb. It has raised 2in letters, and is of oxidised silver. Ornamental leaves and football are also oxidised silver.

The small shields are silver-plated, and will contain the name of winning club and also players' names. The laurel wreath is in oxidised silver, and the circle with the donor's name is silver-plated; the inscription is engraved and enamelled in blue. Emblems are set in the circle, and a title of the shield has letters in a quartered brass.

The case is made of Queensland maple and is rosewood stained. The size is 4ft 2in by 2ft 8in, by 1/2in. Two square points are fixed to the back of the case and the legs are 2 1/2in and 2 3/4in. Quarter inch plate-glass covers the top and sides with green baize inside has a silver monogram with the letters 'J.S.F.A.'. The case was made by Mr. P. Drummond, of Fella-street, Woollahra, an ex-Soccer player, who lost limb in the Great War.

Thirty-seven teams entered the competition, arranged for the Stewart Shield, which commenced on June 1 and is conducted on lines similar to the Scottish Cup. Teams from all four grades (except junior minor) entered. The semi-finals will be conducted at Raymond Park, Kangaroo Point, and arrangements can be made the final to be staged at the Brisbane Cricket Ground, Woolloongabba.

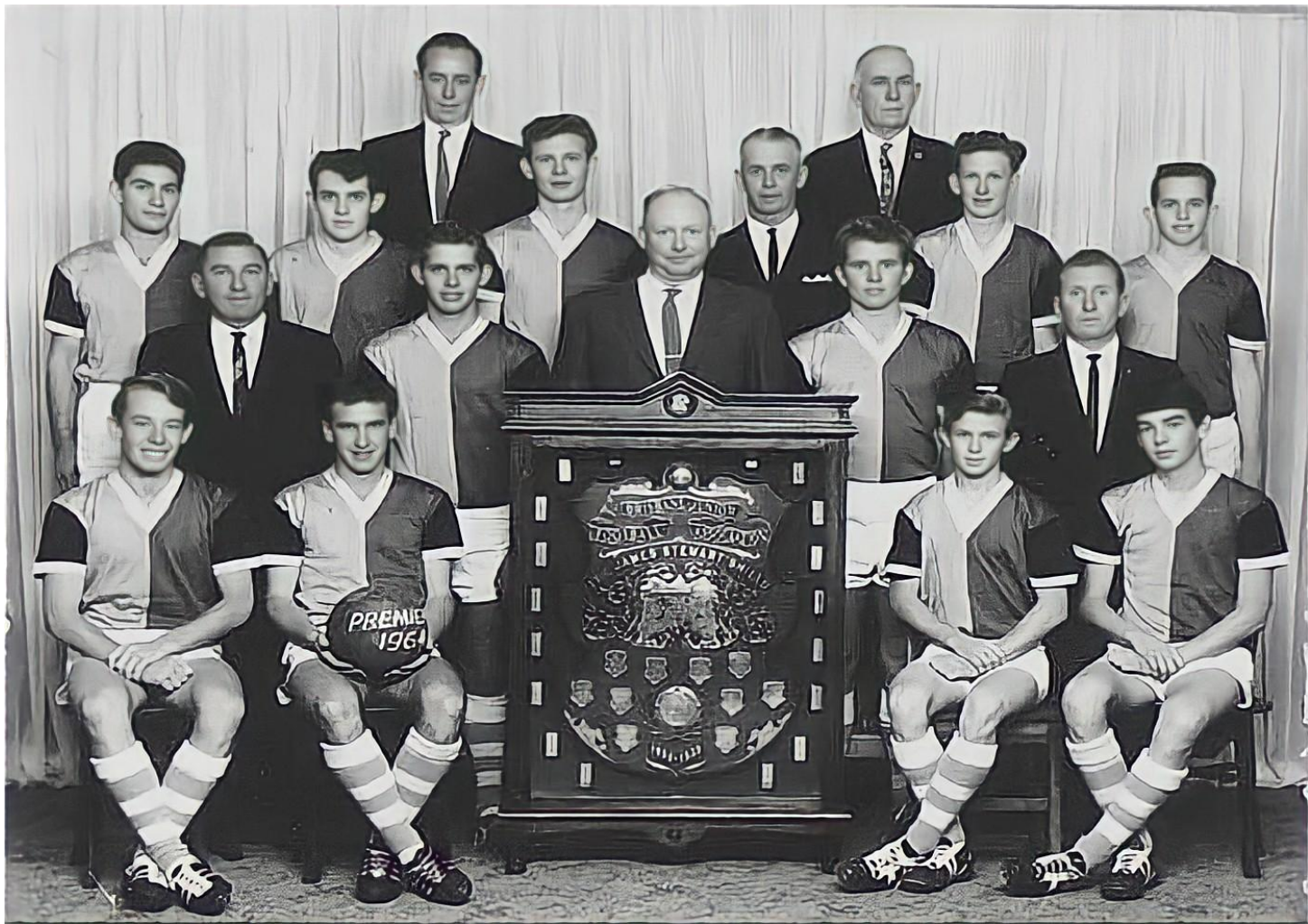
