Billy Williams, who is well known as treasurer and provider of the Booval Bowling Club, and who spent 50 years in various mines in the Ipswich district, recalled during the week that he had scored for the Blackstone team before the old Coolgardie shaft was put down at Blackstone, prior to 1893

He was only a schoolboy then, but he can remember games being played in the Coolgardie paddock before the mine was flooded. It was necessary to build a drain across the playing field, so the late Lewis Thomas cleared another site and gave it to the sporting bodies. It was necessary to shift five houses which were erected on the creek bank and two near the railway line. Today that ground is still known as the Blackstone oval and is used for Soccer fixtures

**Blackstone Rovers continually attacked the Bundamba goal in first division Soccer fixtures on Saturday to cause one of the biggest upsets in Soccer history**

*Steady Blackstone mowed Rangers down using the west wind with more Intelligence, and playing steadier football, Blackstone Rovers sprang a real surprise on Saturday by knocking Bundamba Rangers (3-nil) from the head of the first division Soccer premiersip table. St. Helens, who won their fixture, now head the table. In the opening fixture of the season Bundamba Rangers defeated Blackstone Rovers 6-nil at Blackstone. On Saturday week Rovers were down 7-nil to Thistle. The uncrushable spirit of Blackstone was evident in the way they were able to come back after those two severe reverses. Rangers were under a handicap on Saturday with the Rule brothers - Ray and Norm. - out for the fixture. and an injury early in tile second half to Spencer Kitching. Rangers, how ever, had their opportunities and forwards threw them away with wild shooting. Rovers, playing against a .strong west wind in the first half, refused to be rattled into out-of-position play by the fast Bundamba forward line. They took everything Bundamba hurled against them and yet netted in the 30th minute of the half. Their other two goals were scored in the last quarter of an hour. Rovers' splendid use of the lessening wind in the see ond half was an object les son to Bundamba. Their backs with clean, precision punting gave the forwards a heavy delivery of the ball to run the Bundamba de fence ragged at times. It is doubtful if Rovers have played better positional Soccer this season than they did on Saturday.*

*Outstanding player for them was centre-half, Alwyn Warren, whose splendid headwork and sure kicking strangled many Bundamba attacks. Running a close second to Warren was Ron. Hughes.*

*Whose wise use of the wind turned defence into attack. Reg. Range, switched from left wing to centre forward was a great success in the position. Colin Greisbach, a normal half back, was outstanding for Blackstone as an inside left. Greisbach's fine work was rewarded by a grand solo goal in the last couple of minutes of the game. Bundamba's right full back. Merv. Newlands, was the best of his side , and left half, Ron. Jones next to him. Of the forwards. Neville Cumming showed easily the most penetration. A little more luck and Cumming might have crashed a couple of goals. To the time he was injured, Spencer Kitching also was a trouble to Black. stone's defence. Rovers scored their first goal when Range. following a long drive to Alan Verrall tapped the loose ball into the net.*

*Range got his second goal when he threw himself at a cross by right winger Col. Miller, to take the bill into the net with his foot. Miller's lead-up work to the goal was good Soccer. Greisbach dribbled his way past a number of Bundamba players to beat goal. keeper Wal. Mitchell with a left foot drive 'in the last couple of minutes*
