

Mattia Bognuda (1835-1905) Susannah (1842-1900)

Mattia Goespi was born in Switzerland and arrived in Australia in 1854 on the ship Ida in 1886

Mattia sons involved in soccer were Matthew, Victor, William, Antonio and Joseph

Matthew was born in a tent in Bendigo at the time of the gold rush

Victor played for Dinmore Bush Rats and Reliance and was President of Bush Rats

His brothers Antonio and Joseph played for Dinmore in 1891

Matthew accepted a position, to manage jointly the Dinmore Brick/Tile Works.

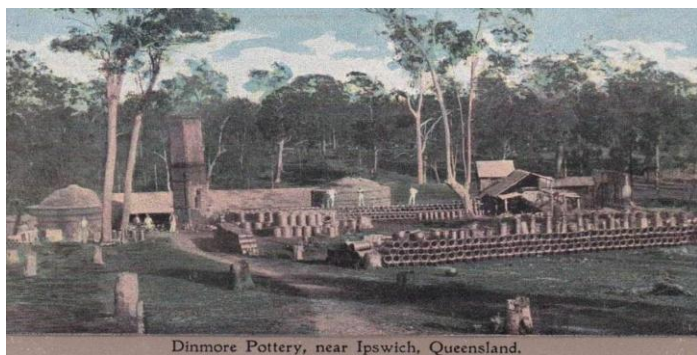
Two years later he, in company with Messrs Joseph and George Hudson, started the brick, tile, and pottery works at Dinmore

From the time of his arrival at Dinmore, he was amongst the foremost of those who promote the interests of football

He would be Vice President of Bush Rats and was Chairman of the Purga Council

He was for many years on the committee of the Dinmore State School and is also member of the Ipswich Chamber of Commerce and Industry

Bognuda Street, Bundamba was named after Mathew Bognuda



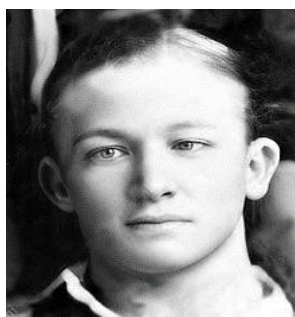
