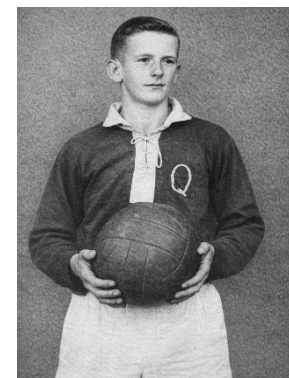

Schoolboys Involved In Brisbane's Worst Crash of Kind

BRISBANE, July 26.—Brisbane's worst bus and tram collision, in which both vehicles were almost totally destroyed by fire, occurred at Woolloongabba at 5.10 p.m. to-day and resulted in 24 persons being admitted to hospital. Six were dangerously injured.

The bus, carrying the New South Wales and Queensland schoolboy Soccer players, was city bound from Wynnum when it swerved into an outbound Balmoral tram in Stanley-street, near the Woolloongabba railway yards. Thrown on its side the bus immediately burst into flames which also engulfed the front cabin of the tram.

The schoolboys, some cut and burned, poured from the blazing bus through the front door and rear window, but several people were trapped in the tram cabin.

Shocking scenes were witnessed as men and women, some burnt almost beyond recognition, rolled and screamed on the roadway in agony. Two fire reels, seven ambulance cars and dozens of police arrived within a few minutes, and the ambulances and taxis maintained a shuttle service to both the Mater and General hospitals.
