Amos,George,Albert, Elisha,Walter,David (Dick),Sydney,William,Arthur,May

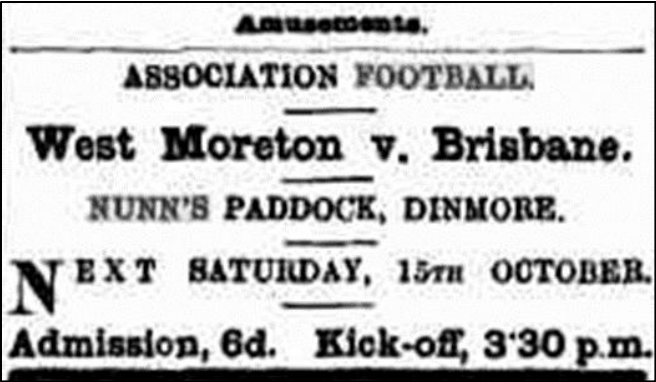


Queensland Times Saturday 3 September 1910

A delightful feature of the football matches in the Dinmore district is the interest evinced in these soccer battles by the women-folk. This has, however, always been in evidence with the followers of the Bush Rats, and I was delighted to notice the large assemblage of the feminine sex. Mothers, wives, and sisters were there in great force, and it was pleasing to again meet that good old lady, Mrs. D. Nunn, who has been in that district some 53 years : she stated that the whole of her family (12 in all) were all alive, that she had 72 grandchildren, and quite a number of great grand-children. The women seem to regard the football matches as occasions for homely gatherings, and every available log was lined with 'happy and smiling faces. It was likewise pleasing to again "rub shoulders" with those who have been stout defenders of the Bush Rats' laurels in many a hard-fought battle with metropolitan soccerites.

Her pleasant familiar face will certainly be missed by the Bush RatsShe leaves behind a numerous family, of whom all the sons are engaged in the coal-mining industry

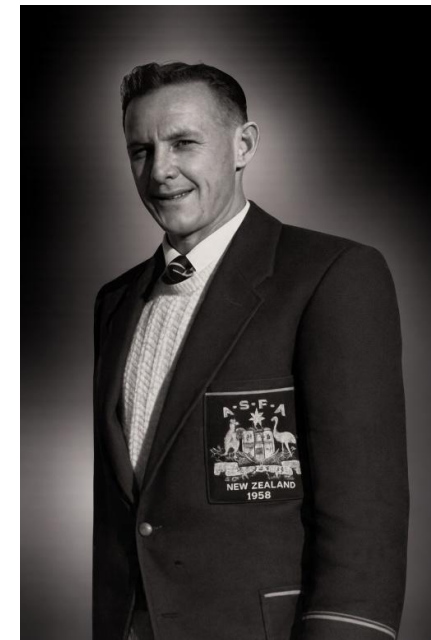
Gordon scored 56 goals for Australia in 52 games.The second highest of any player

Bunny was not eligible for the Olympics in 1956 as he was considered professional for signing in 1951 for 1 pound three pence a match for Caledonians

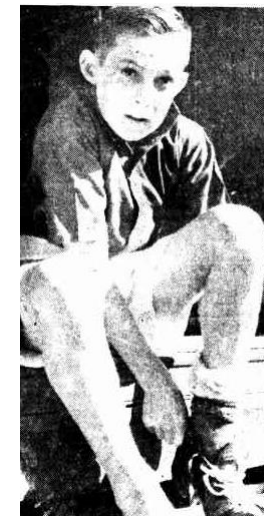
