Spencer Theater is unable to accommodate any pre-show or post-show meals or picnics on-site.

PAYMENTS:

Schools may submit a purchase order. Ticket orders will not be held unless payment or a school purchase order is received within 10 days of the order date.

Payment is required at time of order for home school students, family, and friends by check, cash, or credit card.

SEATING:

Seating is general admission. We will organize seats for the various grade/age levels of the students, keeping classes or schools together if possible.

ALL SALES ARE FINAL:

We are not able to give refunds unless the show is canceled. In case a school officially closes (due to weather, etc.) on the day you planned to attend, we will allow an exchange for another performance within the same season if space permits. Official notification in writing from the principal within 3 business days of the missed performance will be necessary before any adjustments can be made.

CONFIRMATION:

We will send an email confirmation of each ticket order.

TICKET VOUCHERS:

Prior to the performance, we will email a voucher noting the total number of students and adults on the order.

TRANSPORTATION:

The teacher or principal must arrange bus transport. Schools in the districts of Ruidoso, Capitan, Carrizozo, Corona, Hondo and Mesalero may be reimbursed for busing costs. Forward your invoice to the theater to the attention of the business office. All school districts assume full & sole liability for transportation services.

The performances begin on time, so please allow plenty of time for travel and bathroom breaks -- the theater is located 30 minutes from central Ruidoso.

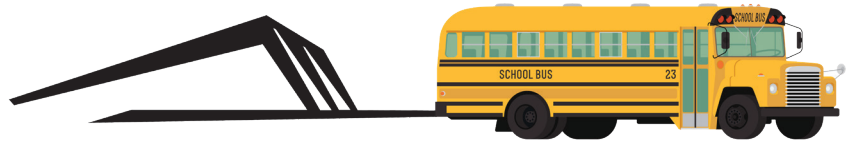
GRADE LEVELS:
