Upon my return from vacationing in Georgia, I received some disturbing news about a surge of COVID cases in Florida, due in large part to the highly transmissible "Delta Variant." As a result of this State AND Nationwide increase in cases, the CDC has revised its guidelines recommending the wearing of masks at indoor gatherings. I have included links to the most recent data released by the State, and the revised CDC guidelines below. Florida's own official data show a sharp spike in cases statewide AND in Martin County for the week of July 16-23.

I have contacted our Church Council with proposal that Trinity UMC of Jensen Beach temporarily reinstate its mask and physical distancing practices, beginning this Sunday:

- In accordance with CDC guidelines, masks will be required in the Sanctuary during worship, vaccinated people included.
- Every other pew will be roped off.
- Please maintain a safe distance while sitting in the sanctuary. Couples and families sit together.
- Greet one another with smiles, waves, bows or "namastes."
- We will offer Communion using sealed cups and wafers.
