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Practice Update

Thank you for being a valued patient. I want to take a moment to share an important update regarding my practice. After much personal thought and consideration, I have decided to shift the focus of my practice exclusively to pain management, sports injuries, auto injuries, nutritional counseling, lifestyle modification, and breathwork.

I will continue to perform physical exams and order blood work; however, as of May 1, 2025, I will no longer be writing prescriptions for Legend and Scheduled drugs. (Legend and Scheduled drugs are commonly referred to as prescription drugs/medications.)

When I began my practice in 1994, I was excited by the expansion of naturopathic laws to include certain prescription rights. However, over time, I have come to realize that my true passion lies in providing complementary care and natural medicine, rather than prescribing pharmaceuticals. My goal has always been to support my patients through a holistic approach, and I remain committed to helping you achieve optimal health through these methods.

In addition, I will be terminating my chiropractic contract with United Healthcare (UHC) around the same date. UHC patients with a commercial plan (through an employer) may have manipulation benefits billable as osteopathic manipulation (OMT) under my naturopath license. In the past UHC paid for manipulation whether billed under OMT (naturopathic license) or CMT (chiropractic license), but we cannot make the guarantee for all plans. If you have questions about this, please contact my office and speak with Byron, my office manager/biller, as he is very knowledgeable about this.

What does this mean for you? If I currently prescribe/manage prescription drugs on your behalf, you will need to consult another provider for refills and ongoing management after May 1, 2025. I will no longer be providing PCP services where prescription drugs are involved. Please start your planning now to ensure continuity of care. If you need a copy of your records sent to another office, we will do so free of charge (when transferred by fax or secure email).
