About our cheerleading program

New York All Stars combines the community spirit of traditional cheerleading with the safety and training levels established by industry standards for all star competitive cheer. Our program welcomes athletes of all ability levels and focuses on foundational skills in tumbling, stunts, jumps and synchronized choreography. We perform throughout the year and attend local competitions in the Spring (all within the tri-state area). Our goal is to encourage excellence. We receive feedback from judges and continue practicing to improve our scores. Trophies are never guaranteed but the experience builds discipline, teamwork, determination and other skills to last a lifetime.

Club Cheer (Ages 8–19 as of Sept. 1)

Same fun-less time and financial commitment!

- 1-hour weekly practice
- Local performances and 1-2 spring competitions
- All participants are placed on a team, as long as we can accommodate their age group
- Tuition is \$80 per month plus apparel & events (see page 8)



🗰 All Star Cheer (Ages 6–19 as of Sept. 1)

For athletes—and parents—ready to be "ALL IN"!

- 2-3 hours of practice weekly
- Local performances
- 3-5 competitions, including one National Championship
- Athletes are placed on teams based on age and ability
- While we aim to include everyone interested, placement is not guaranteed
- Tuition is \$115 per month plus apparel and events (see page 7)







What to expect

Your child will be placed on a team of up to 16 athletes, grouped by similar age and ability level. While we do include some fun, traditional cheerleading elements throughout the year, All Star Cheer has a different focus. Unlike sideline cheer, we do not use pom-poms or megaphones, and there's no actual "cheering" for a sport - Instead, we are the sport! Our athletes train to perform a 2-minute routine set to customized music, featuring synchronized jumps, stunts, tumbling, and dance.

Payment Policies

Monthly Payment Plans

Families on a monthly payment plan must enroll in Auto-Pay with either a credit/debit card or ACH draft via the secure parent portal. Your account will be charged on the 25th of each month for the upcoming month's tuition. Monthly payments are a way to fulfill your season-long tuition commitment—they do not represent a month-to-month enrollment. You are responsible for the full tuition amount for the season.

PLEASE NOTE: In order to ensure accounting accuracy, we will NOT ACCEPT Venmo, Zelle, Apple Pay for monthly tuition payments. All payments must be made through the parent portal. You may update your payment information at any time. Alternative forms of payment will only be accepted for point of sale merchandise.

Tuition

Tuition is non-refundable and will not be pro-rated, refunded, or credited due to scheduled closures, inclement weather, or other circumstances beyond our control—including but not limited to public health emergencies, safety concerns, mechanical issues, or natural disasters. In the case of an extended closure, programming will resume virtually. If a class is canceled due to instructor illness, every effort will be made to schedule a makeup class. If more than two classes are canceled in a single semester and cannot be made up, a credit will be applied to your family's account for future use. Tuition rates are based on the full season and include all regularly scheduled classes. Additional practices scheduled near events are included at no extra charge

Late and Returned Payments

A \$35 fee will be automatically applied to any returned or declined transaction or fee that is 5 days late.

Outstanding Balances

Students with unpaid balances will not be permitted to attend classes, rehearsals, or performances. You cannot register for events, additional classes or merchandise if you owe a balance. If you are experiencing financial difficulty, please contact us as soon as possible—we're happy to discuss options such as individual fundraisers to help meet your tuition commitment.

Cancelling Membership

We carefully place each member on the team with consideration for the entire season. Quitting mid-year can cause the team significant set-backs. Canceling membership after January 1st will result in a charge of \$150 to replace your athlete, re-choreograph and train a new member. If the fee is not collected, you will continue to be billed for the remainder of the season and subject to collections pursuit.

New York All Stars Program Policies

- 1. Students should be prepared and on time for every scheduled class or event. This includes proper attire, hair away from the face, and water. Water is the only beverage allowed!
- 2. **Attendance**: Cheerleading is a team sport in which every member of the team is needed at every practice. Attendance at all practices and events is **mandatory**. You must communicate in advance if your child will be late or miss a class due to illness or a pre-planned conflict. Punctuality is also important. If your child is late to practice they are missing valuable warm-up and conditioning time which could cause injury. Frequent tardies or unexcused absences will result in your child losing the privilege to perform or compete. **Please note: Practice the two weeks before a competition is mandatory. If your child is not at the last practice before an event for any reason, they will not compete. You can log an expected absence in your Parent Portal the link is available on our website: www.newyorkallstars.org**
- 3. **Classes are drop-off**, except for invited performances. While we have allowed parents to stay, the noise is challenging for teaching due to an echo in the gym. Parents who stay in the gym are asked to quietly watch practice without talking. Parents more than 15 minutes late for pick-up may be subject to a \$15 late pick up fee to cover the cost of our staff's overtime.
- 4. What to wear: Cheer shoes, New York All Stars t-shirt, black leggings or shorts. Girls should wear a sports bra or tank under their t-shirt. You may also purchase NYAS practice wear from our online store. We will also have several in-uniform practices. Hair should be up and out of the face. Performances will have required hair styles and make-up. ABSOLUTELY NO JEWELRY OF ANY KIND, including stud earrings. These are significant safety risk and we will not be responsible for lost or misplaced jewelry.
- 5. **During classes:** No food, No Gum, No Phones (unless the device is used for instruction/music/research under the supervision of a teacher). Water is the only beverage allowed at practice.
- 6. **No side-coaching:** Parents should try to avoid coaching children during classes or performances. Our staff will provide guidance for how to help your child practice at home.
- 7. Join the BAND APP: This is a required tool which we will use for communication, practice tips and challenges and sharing of videos and pictures.
- 8. The New York All Stars brand is the result of dedicated collaboration with our trusted partner vendors and the creative vision of our team. While we love seeing team spirit and enthusiasm, the replication, reproduction, or sale of merchandise featuring our name and/or logo without prior authorization is strictly prohibited.
