### Questions & Answers >>>

## Q: Who did the Board appoint to the vacated Board Seats?

**A:** Doug Kreie and Gene Cowles were appointed to the DVCA Board, serving one-year Director positions. Doug Kreie will be the new liaison to the Arc Committee, and Gene Cowles will be the new liaison the CC&R's committee. Thank you to all volunteers!

#### Q: Are solicitors allowed in the DVCA?

**A:** No. Our community gated entrances have signs warning of no solicitation. Should you get solicitors knocking on your door, get the company info and any other details, and submit a complaint to our management company or submit details via the DVCA website 'Contact Us' page. Creating a record of a solicitation complaint can help track community solicitation activity.

## Q: <u>How do I report an aggressive or excessively barking dog?</u>

**A:** Complaints regarding dogs should be directed to the Lyon County Animal Services. You can submit a report and Animal Services will indicate next steps to the animal complaint. (775) 577- 5005 or lyon-county.org You can also file a noise complaint with our management company, FSR.

#### Q: <u>Did the DVCA streets get swept?</u>

**A:** Yes, on May 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> the DVCA streets were swept by EPS, as approved by the Board in the March 2023 BOD meeting. The streets are anticipated to be swept again in the Fall to help keep drains cleared.

### Message from the DVCA President >>> Carla Cole

Greetings,

With a month behind the newly elected board, we have been extremely busy, I must say we are a high-functioning board, and a pleasure to work with each and every one of them.

The Board and especially the Newsletter Committee appreciate all the positive comments about the newsletter. The newsletter aims to share important information with the community, and I believe we have achieved that and will continue to do just that.

As a community, we need to address speed-related issues that have been a concern for many years. I firmly believe that community involvement is key to sustainable change. We have seen a significant increase in traffic volume over the past few years here in the community and in the Northern Nevada area. As residents of the Dayton Valley Community Association, we all have a shared responsibility to ensure the well-being of our community. The Board is researching different ways to slow down cars in our community streets, and we'd like your input by letting us know what you think by responding to our survey about speed.

Participate by going to the DVCA Website; select Documents >> Newsletters and Surveys, and take the speed survey online. Or by filling out the survey on page 8 of the newsletter and dropping it off at the DV Golf Course lobby. We will explore concepts like speed cameras, radar speed signs, speed bumps, street painting or additional stop signs. Only one survey response per DVCA household. We will set aside extra time at the July Board Meeting for input from the community. I encourage all households to talk with their family members, renters, vendors and friends about driving slow in the DVCA.

I would like to assure you that no board member(s) can approve any action on behalf of the board outside of an open board meeting. In rare instances of a pending emergency, the board may take a vote by email and must be unanimous. All business of the association is to take place in an Open Session Board Meeting.

The only time the board can meet privately is in Executive Session to; A) Consult with the attorney on matters relating to proposed or pending litigation (attorney-client privileged conversation). B) Discuss a CAM's character, alleged misconduct, professional incompetence, or physical or mental health. C) Discuss a violation of the governing documents, including failure to pay an assessment. D) Discuss the alleged failure of a unit owner to adhere to a construction schedule. Reference NRS 116.31085

### DVCA Board of Directors Meeting Highlights >>> May 24, 2023

**Directors Present:** C. Cole, D. Drury, J. Kepler, S. Mass, K. Mitchell, D. Kreie & G. Cowles

- March 2023 Financials: The review of the DVCA's March 2023 financial summary was read aloud and records are now available on the DVCA website and the FSR Resident Connect Portal for homeowners to access and review.
- <u>Code of Conduct Revisions:</u> DVCA legal reviewed and made edits to the DVCA's Code of Conduct policy. The Board reviewed the changes and approved the changes suggested by legal. The Code of Conduct can be accessed on the DVCA website.
- <u>Collection Company Proposals:</u> The Board approved Red Rock to handle collections for the DVCA.
- **Reserve Study Update Proposal:** The Board approved Better Reserve Consultants to assist the Board with updating the 2024 Reserve Study. The proposal was for \$1,350, which included a discount for being a repeat customer.
- Rescind O365 & Review Box Proposal: The Board approved the Box proposal to replace the O365 proposal for association digital records storage.
- **Review P-Card Spending Limit:** The Board approved the P-Card spending limit to be set to \$3,500.
- **Board Member Resignation Acknowledgement:** The Board acknowledged the resignations of C. Hall and S. Gallisdorfer.
- <u>Appoint Board Member:</u> The Board received 3 applications from interested volunteers, and appointed Doug Kreie and Gene Cowles to fill the two vacated Board seats.
- Restructure/Addition of Committees: The Board approved to rename & accept the updated charter of the 'Roads Committee' into the 'Infrastructure Committee' and broaden the scope to include gatehouses, road signs, gutters & drains. The Board approved to merge the 'Website' and "IT Infrastructure' committees into the 'IT Committee' with the charter scope to include centralized digital records, email & DVCA website mgmt. The Board approved forming a new committee to research emerging local developments around Dayton, called the 'Interface Committee.' Volunteers are working on a charter to identify the committee scope for the Board to review and approve.
- <u>Crack Seal Proposal:</u> The Board approved the SNC proposal for crack seal. Discussions will continue between the Board, Infrastructure Committee and management regarding comments made about scheduling weed removal prior to road work, to avoid paving over water valves and discuss street sweeping/ street blowing prior to work.


The DVCA is schedule for the streets to be crack and sealed in September. Notifications of the work will go out ahead of time to residents on how to prepare.
