## → SEPT 21<sup>st</sup>, IN USA

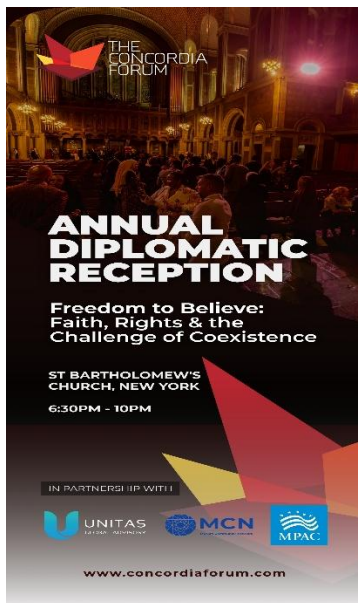
