Private Lesson Scholarship Application

Semester: Fall 2021 <u>Application Due: 8/13/2021</u>

The Georgetown Eagle Band and Eagle Band Boosters understand the importance of a strong private lessons program that is accessible to all students. It is with this understanding that the GHS Band will award deserving students with financial assistance to pursue private lessons.

The GHS Band Private Lesson Scholarship provides a total sum of \$100.00 per student, distributed evenly over ten lessons each curricular semester.

The process of this scholarship works as follows:

- 1. The private lesson instructor charges the student a lesson rate that is \$10.00 less than normal (i.e. a \$26.00 lesson would be charged as a \$16.00 lesson).
- 2. The student pays the reduced lesson rate <u>directly to the lesson instructor</u>. The lesson instructor may collect this rate however they choose (Check, Venmo, etc.).
- 3. The private lesson instructor creates a monthly invoice that tallies the number of scholarship lessons per student per month. The instructor submits this monthly invoice to the Georgetown High School Band.
- 4. The GHS Band pays the instructor according to the submitted invoice via monthly supplemental pay.

If your student is awarded a scholarship, they must abide by the following conditions:

- The student will remain eligible all year. If a student fails a class, they will forfeit their scholarship.
- The student will NOT miss lessons. If the student must miss, you must contact their lesson teacher at least 24 hours in advance. If this is not done, the parent will be responsible for the full cost of the student lesson.
- The student will be punctual to all lessons. Tardiness will not be accepted.
- The student will complete all assignments given by the private lesson teacher. While
 assignments will not be reflected in the student's Band Class Grade, they are considered
 mandatory. If they are not completed to the teacher's full satisfaction, the student will be
 subject to losing their scholarship.
- The student will attend all required rehearsals for the Band program, all year long. If the student has an unexcused absence from rehearsals or performances, the student may lose their scholarship at the band directors' discretion.
