

Hello Eagle Band Family!

I hope everyone is having a wonderful summer! We are SO EXCITED to start our 2023 marching season, especially with the addition of Ms. Leslie Kupetz to the band family! This document has important reminders to make sure we have a successful start, so please take the time to sit down and read this with your student. Band Camp begins on Monday, July 24 at 8:00am, and attendance is MANDATORY for all members. Students should be dropped off at the main band hall (entrance 5) so that they can put their lunches and extra equipment away in their lockers. PLEASE NOTE: You need to drop off your student BEFORE 8:00am to give them enough time to drop off their lunch in their locker and get out to the practice band field. Students should arrive no later than 7:45am (to be early is to be on time ©)! Required Physical and Forms

Per UIL and GISD policy, ALL students must have a physical on the official UIL Pre-Participation form. You can find that form <u>here</u>.

Physicals will be uploaded to Rank 1 and all other "athletic" forms fill out there. Those forms are 1. Physical (uploaded), 2. Concussion Form 3. Drug Testing Form (required for athletes and Fine Arts students)

Student Items Required for Camp

- o SLEEP! It is VERY important for student safety to get 7-8 hours of sleep a night
- o 5 lightweight plain white t-shirts (W&P)
- Lightweight athletic clothing (athletic/basketball shorts (absolutely NO jeans), clean socks, tennis/running shoes - NO flip flops/sandals/crocs/boots/Converse/Toms/Vans etc)



- o Cap or hat
- o Sunglasses
- Healthy Sack Lunch (for student safety, students are not allowed to leave campus during camp)
- Completely filled gallon water jug (non-iced water is healthier)
- o SUNSCREEN (we recommend spf 50 or higher)
- Bug Spray
- Instrument (You must bring your marching <u>AND</u> concert instrument) (Winds)
- o Instrument supplies (valve oil, good reeds, swabs, mouthpiece, ligature, etc) (Winds)
- Sticks/mallets (Percussionists)
- o All Equipment correctly taped in Flag Bag (Guard)
- o Black and White Electrical tape in Flag Bag (Guard)
- o Fanny Pack with Dot Books (Guard will explain at later date)
- Black or Blue 2in binder (W&P)
- O Show Music (Tour from the Tube) and Warm Ups (W&P)
- o PENCILS! (W&P)
- Page protectors (W&P)
- Key or Combination lock for lockers (GHS is not responsible for items in lockers) (W&P)
- POSITIVE AND DETERMIED ATTITUDE!

<u>Correct Clothing and Items to Wear or Bring to Rehearsal</u>

- 1. 5 (lightweight) plain white t-shirts or tank tops (NO SPAGHETTI STRAPS) that does NOT expose cleavage. (Guard: designated plain colored shirts)
- 2. Shorts that are school appropriate (fingertip length). Students may wear SOPHIE type shorts as long as there is some sort of biker shorts or spandex underneath
- 3. Clean, dry socks
- 4. Athletic / Cross Trainer tennis shoes (no skater shoes, Converse [Chuck Taylor's], ballet flats, boots, slippers, sandals, flip flops, crocs, etc.)



- 5. Proper SUPPORTIVE and CORRECTLY FITTING undergarments (sports bras are a necessity) must be worn at all times
- 6. Hair ties / headbands (hair must be pulled back in a ponytail and out of face)
- 7. No jewelry other than studs in ears (make sure to not get any piercings that healing time will prevent you from taking it out). This is to ensure band uniformity.
- 8. Hair must be kept neat and tidy. This is to ensure band uniformity.
- 9. Each student MUST have a bottle of sunscreen with them at all times.
- 10. Each student MUST have a GALLON JUG of water with them at all times.
