1. A letter from a licensed mental health professional or medical doctor (on their letterhead) confirming a disability and the need to have an emotional support animal.	
2. Proof of the animal's medical records and registration, including shots etc.	
3. HIPAA privacy authorization form attached.	
4. It is highly recommended that shareholders have liability insurance included in their HO6 policy (as recommended by the state of Florida). I have liability insurance:	Yes / No
5. All authorized animals must be in the company and control (on a leash) of their owners while in the common areas.	
6. An emotional support animal is not allowed in the pool or the fenced-in pool area.	
7. The individual owner is responsible for removing the animal's excrement.	
8. Application for an emotional support animal must be provided at least one month before the arrival of the animal. Any animal that arrives prior to Board approval must leave the Ambassador South premises immediately.	
9. All animals are subject to the associations noise and other nuisance restrictions. Violations will result in the	
10. A shareholder is responsible for all damage their animal causes to the common area or the property of others.	
11. Failure to observe the rules and procedures as summarized here and stated in the House Rules and Regulations will result in service fees and/or fines and/or revocation of authorization.	
12. Authorization for an emotional support animal can be withdrawn if the animal poses a health or safety threat.	
13. Dogs should not exceed 25 lbs.
