Learning Garden Maintenance

- 1. Pickup sticks in Woodlot Area before mowers. Usually Monday or Saturday
- 2. Make sure electric fence is working using tester for voltage.
- 3. Prune overgrown Viburnams which may be shorting out fence.
- 4. Mowing inside Learning Garden at least once per week or before special events.
- 5. Checking for holes under fence and damage to plants from rabbits/groundhogs. Using smoke bombs where holes occur.
- 6. Treating lawn area for crabgrass before season.
- 7. Care of outside area around shrubs with wood chips.
- 8. Apply wood chips in aisles and pathways.
- 9. Shred Plant Material and Waste in Compost Bin.
- 10. Organize, Clean and Maintain Master Gardener Building.
- 11. Remove Weeds and Trees from Viburnam area.
