

## Learning Garden Maintenance

1. Pickup sticks in Woodlot Area before mowers. Usually Monday or Saturday
2. Make sure electric fence is working using tester for voltage.
3. Prune overgrown Viburnams which may be shorting out fence.
4. Mowing inside Learning Garden at least once per week or before special events.
5. Checking for holes under fence and damage to plants from rabbits/groundhogs. Using smoke bombs where holes occur.
6. Treating lawn area for crabgrass before season.
7. Care of outside area around shrubs with wood chips.
8. Apply wood chips in aisles and pathways.
9. Shred Plant Material and Waste in Compost Bin.
10. Organize, Clean and Maintain Master Gardener Building.
11. Remove Weeds and Trees from Viburnam area.
