Where?

Use: Prepositions of place are used to determine the location of something

<i>at</i>		<i>He is at the bus stop</i>
<i>on</i>		<i>The plant is on the desk.</i>
<i>in</i>		<i>The money is in the bag</i>
<i>next to</i>		<i>The camera is next to the plant</i>

Prepositions of Place

Where?

<i>between</i>		<i>The bus is between the cars.</i>
<i>opposite</i>		<i>The TV is opposite the chair.</i>
<i>under/below</i>		<i>The bin is under the desk. The bin is below the desk</i>
<i>over/above</i>		<i>The balloon flies over the town. The balloon is above the town</i>
