Comparative adjectives

Use

To show differences between two different things

Form

For one syllable adjectives add *-er*

High High*er*

If the word ends in y remove the 'y' and add *-ier*








healthy Health*ier*

For two or more syllable adjectives add '*more*' before the adjective

Expensive *more* expensive

Irregular forms

Some adjectives are irregular and have their own forms

<i>Adjective</i>		<i>Comparative</i>
Good		<i>Better</i>
Far		<i>Further</i>
Bad		<i>Worse</i>
Well		<i>Better</i>
Little		<i>Less</i>
Many		<i>More</i>

Sentence Form (Examples)

Noun	Verb	<i>Comparative adjective</i>	Than	Noun
Louise	jumps	<i>higher</i>	than	Michael
Usain Bolt	runs	<i>faster</i>	than	me
Politicians	are	<i>More annoying</i>	than	Musicians
Water	is	<i>Healthier</i>	than	cola
