

Prepositions of Place







Use

	<i>Behind</i>
	<i>In front of</i>
	<i>Opposite</i>
	<i>On the left</i>
	<i>On the right</i>

Question	Answer
Where is the café?	It is next to the salon
Where are the café chairs?	They are in front of the café
Where is the barber?	The barber is on the left
