

# Adjectives

## Superlatives

### Use

Superlative adjectives are used to compare three or more people, places or things

### Form

For one or two syllable adjectives add *-est*

High                      Highest

If the word ends in a consonant add an additional consonant

Big                      biggest

If the word ends in y, remove the 'y' and add *-iest*

Healthy                      healthiest

For two or more syllable adjectives add *'most'*

Expensive                      most expensive

*'the'* is used with superlative adjectives

















*The* Highest

*The* Healthiest

*The* most expensive

### Irregular forms

Some adjectives are irregular and have their own forms

<i>Irregular comparatives and superlatives</i>				
<i>Adjective</i>		<i>Comparative</i>		<i>Superlative</i>
Good		Better		<i>Best</i>
Far		Further		<i>Furthest</i>
Bad		Worse		<i>Worst</i>
Well		Better		<i>Best</i>
Little		Less		<i>Least</i>
Late		Later		<i>latest</i>
Many		More		<i>most</i>
