Use

Giving advice is when you suggest actions to other people.

The word *should* is often used as a way of asking for and offering advice.

Form

Should is a modal verb. It is followed by the infinitive of the main verb without *to*.

	Should	Infinitive of the verb	
Sentence	You should study more		
Negative	Louisa shouldn't	stay up so late.	
Question	Should I	Ask the builder for help?	

Should is a modal verb which does not change form

	First person	Second person	Third person
Singular	I should go.	You should go.	He/She should go.
Plural	We should go.	You should go.	They should go.
