used to do

Meaning and use

Used to do is to describe habits, situations or a series of events in the past which no longer happen.

For example: I *used to* live in Paris (*Meaning - I do not live in Paris now*)

Form

used to is followed by a base verb e.g. *She used to ride a bike.*

used to does not change its form according to person or singular and plural.

used to follows the grammar of past tense verbs:

Sentence	Luisa <i>used to</i> live in Mexico, but she lives in Canada now.
Negative	When she lived in London, she <i>didn't use to</i> walk to work.
Question	<i>Did</i> she <i>use to</i> have a car? How <i>did</i> she <i>use to</i> get about?
