

# Using Imperatives

## Use

The imperative is used for signs and notices.  
It is also used for orders, instructions, invitations and directions

## Form

The verb goes at the beginning of the sentence.

+	<i>Turn right at the end of the road.</i> <i>Go to the back of the queue.</i>
-	<i>Don't eat the cake.</i> <i>Don't worry about it.</i>

## Sequencing words

- We can show the order of instructions and directions by using these sequencing words.

*first*

*then*

*next*

Here are some instructions for how to make tea.

*First* boil some water. *Then* put the water in a cup with a tea bag. *Next* take the tea bag out. *Then* add milk.
